Monster Meter Mash!

Set up your playing area:

- 1. Put one of the meter cards at the left side to begin
- 2. Place the plain beat sticks in a straight row going to the right
- 3. Count out the beats by the top number of your meter card (2, 3, 4, or 6) and add a pipe cleaner measure line in between each set of sticks
- Swap out the first plain stick in each measure for an orange stick to mark the downbeat

Put on your monster and "mash that beat!" - here are some games!

- 1. Monster Mash listen to a piece of music (or sing a song you know) and have your monster tap the beat along with the music. Is your meter the correct one for the music? How do you know? Try a different piece of music.
- 2. <u>Meep Moop, Bleep Blap</u> Have your monster invent its own language and count out the beats in each measure. Be sure to make a different sound for the downbeats. With other monsters in your group make a monster symphony by counting the beats all together in their own languages!
 - Change the tempo and read it again!

3. Monster Meter Makers! - 2 players

- a. One person pulls a meter card from their set
- b. Both players race to see who can set up their beat line with measures and downbeats in the correct place. This winner gets a point and the other player's monster reads the correct meter line using its invented language.
- c. Repeat until all the meter cards have been pulled.
- d. If you pull a ? card, make up your own meter using any number on top from 5 to 9. Both of you read this meter with your invented language.

PREPPING the GAME for WHOLE CLASS or STATIONS:

Materials Needed:

- 1. One Plastic ziplock bag/game sandwich or quart sized
- 2. Instruction Page printed on orange or other colored paper, laminated if possible
- 3. Print the meter pages on card stock all same color for playing "Meter Maker"; cut into individual meter cards, make one set of 2, 3, 4, and ?/4 per bag
- 4. 20 Wooden popsicle sticks plain wood color / game
- 5. 4 colored popsicle sticks / game to show the downbeat
- 6. Black or other colored pipe cleaner pieces 3 / bag, cut to fit flat in bag (I cut one pipe cleaner into 3 equal pieces) to show the measure lines
- 7. A monster finger puppet or picture of monster taped to a stick, or use pointer finger to be the monster
