Key Responsibility Areas

Curriculum

- To observe Primary/ Secondary/ High school subjects with regard to the Australian Curriculum framework.
- To observe SACE subjects.
- To support subject teachers to prepare and submit programs each semester in line with school requirements.
- To support teaching, learning and assessment activities and feedback to students using the school's Learning Management System.

Assessment and Reporting

- To support subject teachers to assess and report on student achievement in line with the Australian Curriculum Achievement Standard.
- To learn accurate and comprehensive records of student performance and achievement.
- To learn a variety of formative and summative assessment methods.
- To observe internal and external moderation processes.

Teaching and Learning

- To observe exemplary teaching practice.
- To observe a range of teaching and learning strategies, including but not limited to, direct instruction – whole class and small group, class discussions, group work, independent learning, practical activities.
- To observe formal parent - teacher meetings in accordance with the school parent - teacher meeting arrangements and schedule.
