The ICTM Governance Committee is currently working on selecting a slate of candidates for the 2024 ICTM election. Candidates elected will begin serving on the ICTM Board on January 1, 2025. Please consider nominating exceptional qualified individuals, *including yourself*, who are interested in serving as a leader for other math educators across the state.

This year's election will fill two different roles; At-Large Representative and President-Elect.

- ICTM has three At-Large Representative positions to fill this year. Each of these positions is a 3-year term and can be filled by any math educator.
- The President-Elect will serve for a total of four years. The first year of this term allows for working alongside the President to learn the duties and responsibilities of the office prior to officially taking on the duties of President for the next two years. In the last year of the term, this person serves as Past President continuing to provide support for the new President. A candidate for President-Elect should be someone who has had prior ICTM board experience.
