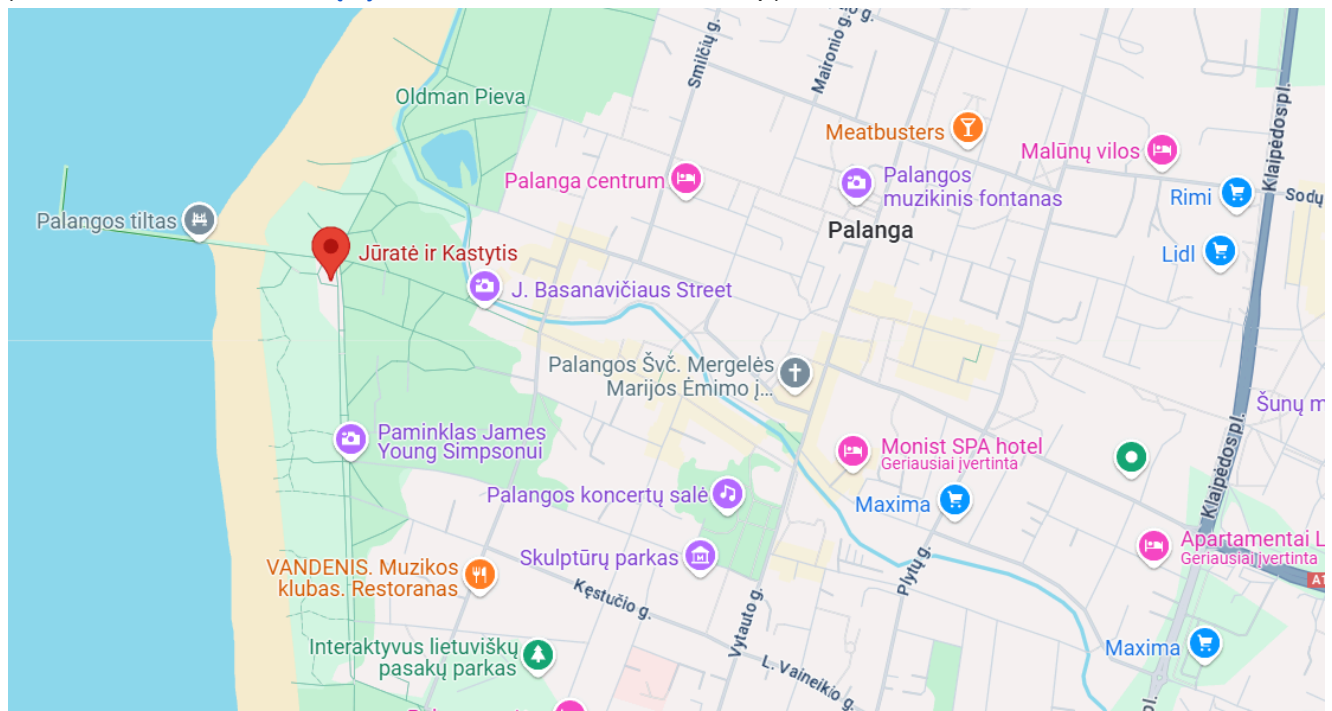

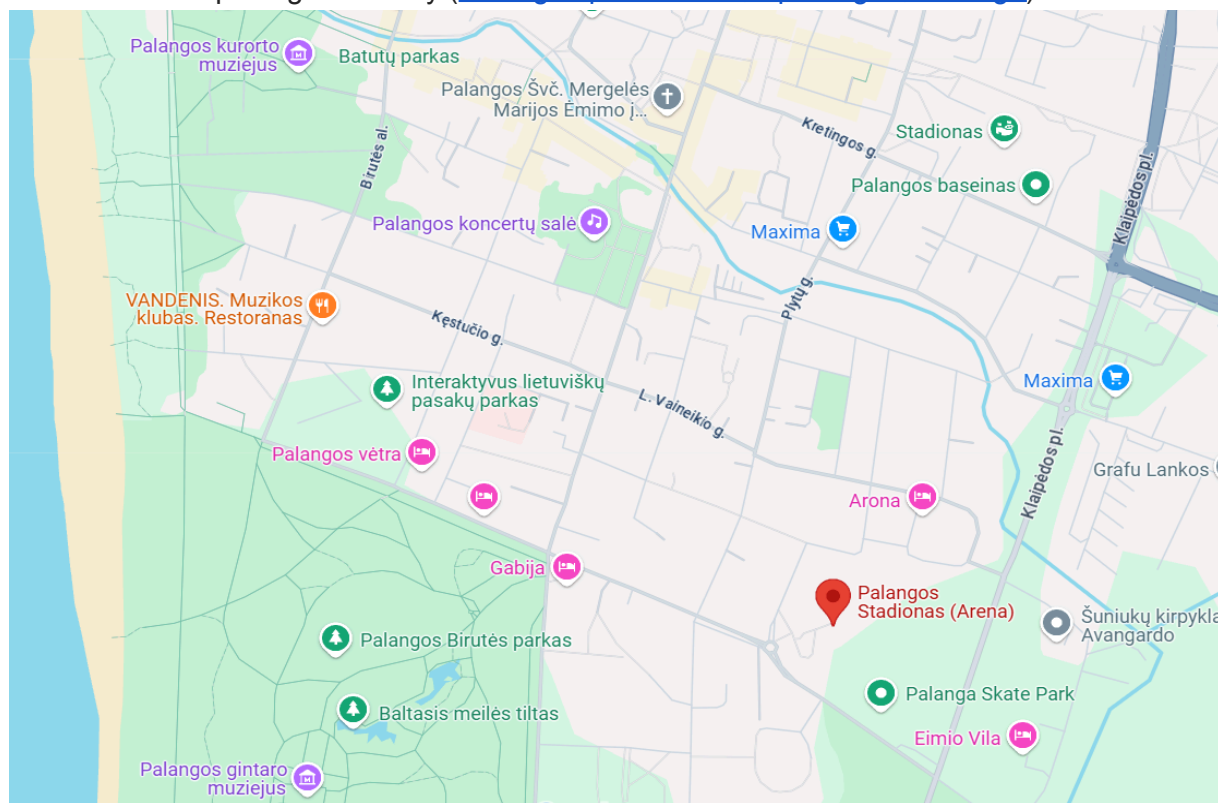

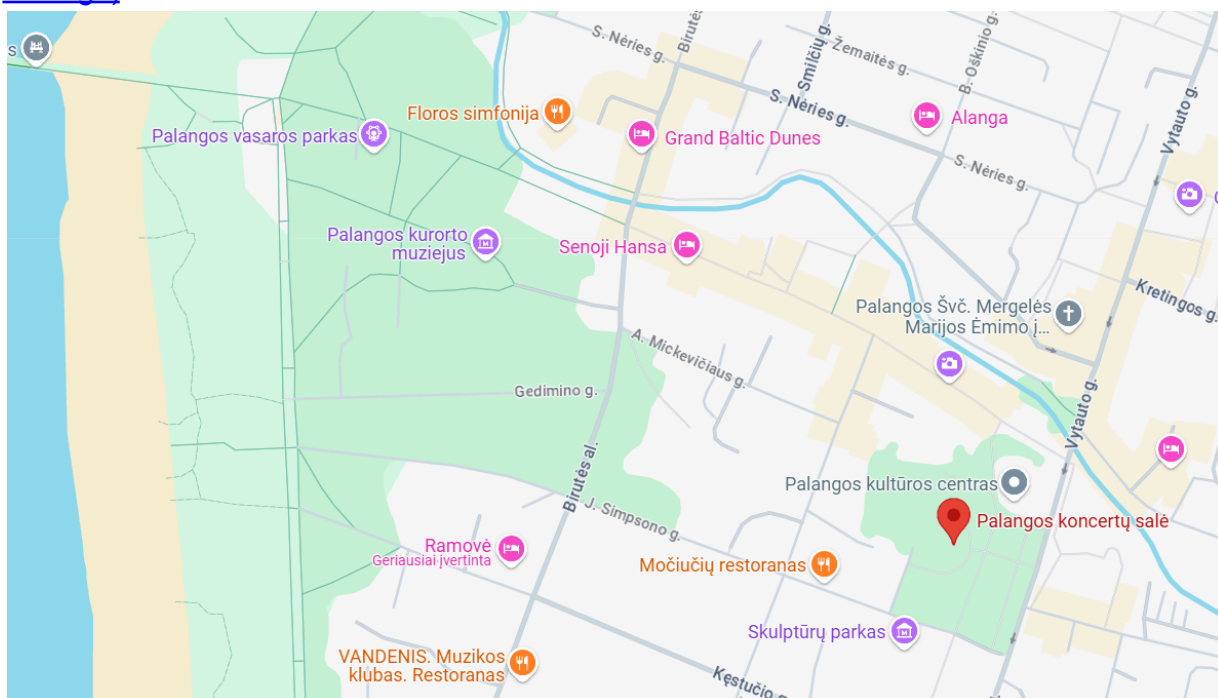

Places to visit:

Natural Wonders & Scenic Spots

- **Palanga Beach & Pier** – Enjoy a relaxing walk or lounge on the long sandy shore. Don't miss the iconic L-shaped pier stretching 470 m into the Baltic—perfect for sunset views and casual fishing.
- **Park & Birutė Hill** – Stroll through this lush 100-ha park filled with sculptures, winding paths, and the historic Birutė Hill. Climb up to the chapel for views over the sea.
- **Palanga Botanical Garden** – Adjacent to the Amber Museum, it's great for a leisurely afternoon among 250 plant species, ponds, fountains, and seasonal blooms.

Cultural & Historical Highlights

- **Palanga Amber Museum (Tiškevičiai Palace)** – Housed in a grand 1897 Neo-Renaissance palace, it showcases ~4,500 amber pieces (out of 28,000 in its collection), including pieces with insect and plant inclusions.
- **Jono Basanavičiaus Street** – The town's main pedestrian promenade leading to the pier, lined with cafés, restaurants, street entertainment, and the "Jūratė and Kastytis" fountain.
- **Church of the Assumption of the Virgin Mary** – A striking Neo-Gothic church at the heart of town, known for its stained-glass interior and a tower lookout with panoramic town views.
- **Sculpture Park** – Discover informal art along pathways near Basanavičiaus Street—a peaceful spot to admire local sculptures.

Family Fun & Unique Finds

- **Dog Museum & Eureka Illusion House** – Quirky and often overlooked, this museum/attraction combo is perfect for families or anyone with a sense of whimsy.
- **Palanga Summer Park / "BOOM Park"** – Ideal for kids and thrill-seekers alike, offering rides, games, and lively summer activities.

Active & Off-the-beaten-path Adventures

- **Bike along the coast** – Rent a bike and ride the scenic route north to Šventoji (~12 km), passing pine forests and dunes.
- **Amber hunting on the beach** – Early morning strolls after a storm can yield small but beautiful amber pieces—nature's treasure hunt.

- Palanga has a large variety of choices, but it is wise to book early to have the best picks.
