Hypothesized Function	Antecedent-Based Interventions
Escape	• Pairing (Build relationships) • Schedule of Reinforcement (Increase rate of reinforcement) • Interspersing (Provide easy/hard tasks at a rate of 80/20) • Behavior Momentum (Provide 2 easy tasks before 1 hard task) • Visual Supports • Choice-Making
Attention	• Pairing (Build relationships) • Schedule of Reinforcement (Increase rate of reinforcement) • Ratio of Praise • Visual Supports • Choice-Making
Tangible	• Pairing (Build relationships) • Schedule of Reinforcement (Increase rate of reinforcement) • Visual Supports • Choice-Making
Automatic Reinforcement	• Schedule of Reinforcement (Increase rate of reinforcement) • Visual Supports • Choice-Making

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
