

AUSTRALIA AND NEW ZEALAND GENERAL meeting Monday, May 5 2025 7:00 for families who have already been to an informational meeting

1. **Jamie** -welcome the group and introduce yourself and Jana.
2. **Jamie**- introduce the rest of the team -Debbie, Trina, Tim, Sam, Scott? and Kendall?
3. We will be talking about various fundraisers and you'll get the opportunity to sign up for these fundraisers. But if you do NOT want to work at BBQ's you need to sign the sheet here so we know this. Every family is responsible for working 2 consecutive days at our BBQ's. This is a HUGE fundraiser but if you choose NOT to work BBQ's then a \$300 fee will be added to your account.
4. Sam – explain how people will sign up for the BBQ's -5 minutes
5. Sam and Scott – explain how a person will set up the BBQ's -15 minutes
6. **Jamie** A) remind the families to join with another family to set up if that is what works for you. B)You need to have a"runner" to get supplies if you're running low on product. C) **Use your own social media to tell family and friends to support you as you're running the BBQ's this day.**This is why the BBQ's did so well last year as all your friends and family will come out to buy from you. D) Always "UPSELL" asking them if they'd like a coke and some cheese on their burger/hotdog. E) Every dollar you spend on something that is frivolous is a dollar that your traveller will not have at the end of the day.
7. Tim and Scott -set up the canopy on stage and go over the points about not forcing the canopy or jamming the canopy. Explain to the families how to secure the canopy and about the weights used to hold the canopy down. -8 minutes
8. Sam - explain "apple pay" as a payment method for both BBQ's C'Tire and Mann Motors
9. Debbie – talk about the Prairie Meat fundraiser
10. Trina – go over your fundraisers with the families –pancake breakfast, ice salt, Mr. Java's coffee, etc. -5 minutes
11. Jana -go over the "Ultimate Perennial Plant Exchange" fundraiser
12. Jana -talk to travellers about getting into groups of 10 in Sept. and how rooming works.
13. Jana -talk about remind one to one -everyone MUST sign up! Facebook and Instagram and tik tok

14. **Jamie** – go on your EF website and check that your emails are correct for BOTH a parent and the student. I can't group email due to so many incorrect emails.

15. **Jamie** -talk to families about school attendance: - If a traveller does not attend school regularly then we won't be able to take said traveller on the trip. A pattern of non-attendance shows us non commitment and /or non-reliability. Irregular attendance may also indicate an unhealthy traveller which we are not equipped to deal with.

16. Jana - talk to families who have a cognitively challenged traveller - For safety reasons, the PAYTC reserves the right to deny the application of travellers to the club who have been diagnosed with cognitive impairments, intellectual disabilities and any other conditions that may be deemed to pose a safety risk to themselves, fellow travellers, or advisors on any trip.
