IF - CLAUSE, MAIN CLAUSE.
MAIN CLAUSE IF-CLAUSE.

ZERO CONDITIONAL - FACTS, TIMELESS TRUTH

If + S + PRESENT SIMPLE, Subject + PRESENT SIMPLE.

If we <u>heat</u> water <u>up</u> to 100 degrees Celsius, it <u>boils</u>.

If we <u>cool off</u> water to 0 degree, it <u>freezes / it turns</u> to ice.

If the temperature <u>drops</u> below freezing point, rain <u>turns</u> into snow.

FIRST CONDITIONAL - REAL, POSSIBLE, LIKELY TO HAPPEN SITUATION

If + S + Present Simple (V1), S + Future Simple (will + V1) / modal verb (can, may)

If you pass the next exam, you will / can move up to the next level.

If you <u>study</u> hard, you <u>will / can get</u> a good score on the exam.

If aspirin will eases my headache, I will take a couple tonight.

If she <u>doesn't hear</u> you, she <u>won't reply</u>. (won't = will not)

I will go to Canada if I get a visa.

If I can speak Spanish fluently, I can / will speak with Cami and Yenny.

TIME CLAUSES (WHEN, AFTER, BEFORE, UNTIL, AS SOON AS)

Time expression (when/after...) + **Present Simple**, S + **Future Simple**

After we finish the grammar exercise, we will do the listening exercise.

I will brush my teeth before I go to bed.

As soon as I finish this class, I will call you.

SECOND CONDITIONAL - UNREAL, IMPOSSIBLE, UNLIKELY TO HAPPEN AND IMAGINARY SITUATIONS

If + S + Past Simple (V2), S + would / could + V1
Be -> were

be - was/were

If I won a lottery, I would buy a new house.

If I were you, I wouldn't go to this party. -> advise

We would go to Canada if the borders were open.

If I didn't study at CCEL I couldn't communicate with all of you.

If I were a bird, I would fly to Hawaii now. - unreal, impossible

If he were a pilot, he could travel easily. - he is not a pilot

If I <u>passed</u> IELTS, I <u>would/could apply</u> for university.

If I <u>lived</u> in my country, I <u>wouldn't practice</u> English easily.

If I go out with damp hair, I <u>WILL catch</u> a cold. - possible
If I <u>went out</u> with damp hair, I <u>would catch</u> a cold. - imaginary

If I study English hard, I will speak well. - possible

If I were a wonder woman, I would / could speak 8 languages / I could fly. - imaginary situation
