

Privacy Policy

1. GENERAL

1. Qwantum Finance Labs, Inc. (the "Company", "we," or "our,") of 855 El Camino Real st, 13A-260 Palo Alto CA 94301 are fully committed to protecting your privacy and your information (personal-identifying Information and general non-personal activity log information, being the "Information").
2. We have created this Privacy Policy to let you know what Information we (or others on our behalf) collect from you when you access and/or use our website located at www.jointer.io (the "Website"), how this Information is collected and how is it used.
3. This Privacy Policy is part of and should be read in conjunction with our Terms of Use. When you access or use the Website, you agree that we (or others on our behalf) may collect, use and disclose the Information in accordance with the terms of this Privacy Policy.

2. COLLECTION OF INFORMATION

1. When you visit or use the Website and in your communications with us, we (or others on our behalf, including but not limited to our affiliates) may collect two types of the Information:
 - a. "Personally identifiable information" that you voluntarily disclose and which is collected on an individual basis, including but not limited to, user name, password, name, company name, email address, billing address and credit card information;
 - b. General "non-personal" activity log information unique to you, including but not limited to:
 - i. Server Log Information which may include (but is not limited to) your login details, the date and time of visits, the pages viewed, your IP address, time spent on the Website and the websites you visit just before and just after visiting the Website.
 - ii. Device Information about the computer or mobile device you use to access the Website, including the hardware model, operating system and version, the web browser you use, and other device identifiers.
 - iii. Telemetry Information if you use any of our open source software, including bandwidth upload and download speeds, the amount of free and used storage space on your device and other device statistics.
 - iv. Usage Information, metadata about the files you upload for storage, recordings of instances in which you have used your private key to authenticate communications.

2. By providing us with your personally identifiable information, you also consent for us to collect, hold, use and disclose your personal information in accordance with this Privacy Policy. In addition to providing the foregoing information, if you choose to correspond further with us through email or through the "Contact" section of our Website we may retain, use and disclose the content of your messages together with your email address and our responses.

3. DATA STORAGE

1. We may use third party vendors and hosting partners to provide the necessary hardware, software, networking, storage and related technology required to run the Website.

4. USE OF INFORMATION

1. We may use the Information for purposes of, including but not limited to:
 - . providing, maintaining, delivering or improving the Website, products or services provided through the Website;
 - i. analyzing and tracking data to determine the usefulness or popularity of certain content and to better understand the online activity of the Website users;
 - ii. fulfilling our legal or regulatory requirements;
 - iii. providing you with the information or products or services that you have requested;
 - iv. responding to your inquiries or to other communication received from you;
 - v. developing new products or services;
 - vi. sending and communicating with you about news, products, services, events and other information we think will be of interest to you;
 - vii. monitoring and analyzing trends, usage and activities in connection with the Website;
 - viii. detecting, investigating and preventing fraudulent transactions or unauthorized or illegal activities;
 - ix. protecting the rights and property of the Company and/or others;
 - x. linking, connecting or combining Information we collect from or about you with other information; and
 - xi. carrying out any other purpose or reason for which the Information was collected.

1. GOOGLE ADWORDS

1. The Website may use the Google AdWords remarketing service to advertise on third party websites (including, but without limiting, Google) to previous visitors to the Website; it could mean that we advertise to previous visitors who haven't completed a task on the Website. This could be in the form of an advertisement

on the Google search results page, or a site in the Google Display Network for example). Third party vendors, including Google, use cookies to serve ads based on someone's past visits to the Website. You understand that any data collected will be used in accordance with the provisions of the Privacy Policy and Google's privacy policy, respectively.

2. 2. SHARING OF INFORMATION

1. We may share your Information to any third parties, provided that the Information is shared:
 - . upon your consent or instruction
 - i. to our current or future parent companies, affiliates, subsidiaries and/or with other companies under common control or ownership with us or our offices internationally;
 - ii. to third parties or service providers that perform work for us;
 - iii. in the event that we sell, assign or transfer some or all of our business or assets to a successor or acquirer, or if we are acquired by or merge with a third party, or if we file for bankruptcy or become insolvent, or any other situation where Information may be sold, assigned or transferred to a successor or acquirer;
 - iv. in response to a request for information if we believe disclosure is in accordance with, or required by, any applicable law, regulation or legal process;
 - v. if we believe your actions are inconsistent with any of our agreements and/or policies, or to protect the rights, property and safety of any of our parties or others;
 - vi. in the event that a data center is compromised by a third party and/or is faced with a security breach; and
 - vii. to third parties where aggregate Information is disclosed which cannot be reasonably used to identify you.
2. We may disclose the Information if required to do so by law, or if we believe in good faith that such action is necessary to comply with applicable regulation, a current judicial proceeding, a court order or legal process, or to protect and defend our rights or property, your personal safety or that of the public. We reserve the right to share the aforesaid Information with banks, credit card companies, and appropriate institutions, if we determine in our sole discretion that it is required in order to comply with applicable regulation or if we suspect you of committing any fraudulent activity (including of fraudulent payment), or any other prohibited transaction.

3. We may transfer the Information outside the jurisdiction which you are a resident of and store it in other jurisdictions and countries; the data protection and other laws of these jurisdictions or countries may not be as comprehensive as those in the jurisdiction which you are resident – in these instances we will take steps to ensure that an appropriate level of protection is given to your Information.
4. Any person who provides the Information to us (or to others on our behalf) in connection with the Website represents to us that they are 18 (eighteen) years of age (or such other lawful age – where higher than 18) or older. It is our policy to try and uncover attempts by minors to access the Website, and this may require having to access and verify your Information. We will not accept and take actions to remove from our records any Information which we discover is or was submitted by a minor.
5. We may share Information with identity-check providers and/or initiate submitting inquiries to data aggregators (such as watch-list checks providers), to maintain that our internal procedures are in compliance with applicable regulation.
6. We will retain the Information only for as long as necessary for the fulfillment of the purposes for which such Information is collected.
