

Teacher Subject Specialism Training (TSST) in MFL

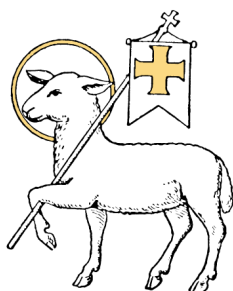
Free training based at St Bonaventure's School during the 2017-18 academic year

The Agnus Dei Teaching School Alliance (ADTSA) is keen to involve schools in our TSST programme and work with them to enhance the subject knowledge of teachers. This programme is designed to address the national shortage of MFL teachers by upskilling existing MFL teachers in a subject that they are not currently teaching (French, German or Spanish) or to upskill teachers who have language skills (native speakers, A Levels, degree, other relevant experience) but are not currently teaching MFL.

This programme adopts a blended learning approach whereby delegates will receive pedagogical input during their 'in school' sessions, observations and coaching in their home school and linguistic upskilling.

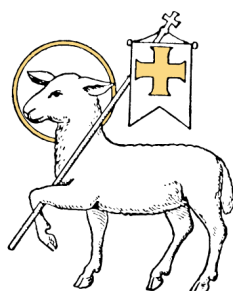
Training will be held at St Bonaventure's School or Goldsmiths University

We have designed a package to pay schools to support the CPD of their staff; our core training involves six, half day sessions. We have put together the following package in terms of financial support to schools for covering lessons to attend the programme:

Incentive	Frequency	Total
In school (home school) observation to support subject knowledge for teaching	1 per term over 3 terms	£300
In school coaching to support planning of lesson and delivery of enhanced subject knowledge knowledge	2 per half term over 4 half terms	£480
