

Lesson 27 - Ezekiel Questions

These questions should be completed before the Wednesday class on **October 9, 2019**. Write your answers either on the back of this page or on a separate sheet of paper. Where possible and appropriate, **CITE THE VERSE** that supports your answer.

1. Where was Ezekiel when God called him to his work?
2. In the vision of the Living Creatures (1:5-14), what is suggested by the combining of man, lion, ox, and eagle in the description?
3. In the vision of the Four Wheels (1:15-21), what do you envision in your mind when you think of a "wheel within a wheel"?
 - a. Two points stand out in the description. First, what point is emphasized by the description of the movement? (note the relation of the whole picture to the manifestation described in vs. 26-28)
 - b. The other point of emphasis is the eyes (v. 18) which also covered the cherubim (10:12). What is emphasized by this feature?
4. In the vision of the Divine Glory (1:26-28) how is God manifested to Ezekiel?
5. What is meant by "briers", "thorns" and "scorpions" in 2:6?
6. What was Ezekiel to do no matter how his words were received?
7. (2:8-3:3) Eating the roll (or scroll) was, of course, a symbolic action. But symbolic of what?
8. Why was it sweet in the mouth, but bitter in the belly?
9. (4:1-3) What was Ezekiel told to do? Think of a child playing war games.
 - a. What was it to be a sign of?
10. (4:9-17) What was the characteristic of Ezekiel's diet during this time? What was the message intended to be conveyed by these eating habits?
11. (5:5-17) How bad had Jerusalem become?
12. (8:5-18) List the various forms of idolatry seen in the temple of Jehovah.
13. Chapter 9 - Can you name at least one person who would fit into the category described in v. 4?
14. 33:1-9 - How is the responsibility of the prophet illustrated?
15. 33:30-33 - What was the attitude of the people toward Ezekiel's preaching?
16. What would show "that a prophet hath been among them"?
17. In the prophecy of the Valley of Dry Bones (37:1-14) - What was the message conveyed by the dry bones?
18. In the prophecy of the Two Sticks (37:15-28) - What did the two sticks represent? What was the message conveyed by joining the two sticks together in Ezekiel's hand?
 - a. The Mormons try to appropriate this passage as a proof text. They claim that the two sticks represent two books, the Bible and the book of mormon. What do you say to such an application of the passage?
19. To what does verses 37:24-28 ultimately point?
