



Setting up Online Tests

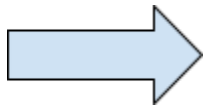
