Dear Friends & Family,

Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. We continue to lift all of you up in prayer daily as we are on opposite sides of the globe, yet dealing with many of the very same issues and circumstances that plague our world today. Thank the Lord that through Christ Jesus we have an eternal hope and perspective as we face each new day. As we are reminded in Matthew chapter six, we can take heart knowing that He cares for us and gives us exactly what we need to make it through one day at a time. In John 16:33 we are reminded that "In the world we will have tribulation. But, take heart Jesus says; "for I have overcome the world." This is exactly what keeps us going each and every day!

That being said, things continue to be very difficult for many all around us and many continue to lose loved ones and circumstances seem unbearable at times. We have lost several close friends and ministry partners in Tanzania and things continue to get worse there. Please be in prayer for Tanzania and all of our ministry partners and dear friends there. Pray that the country's leaders will make necessary decisions to implement some sort of precautionary measures to control the spread and end their denial of Covid.

Here in Kenya over the last few months Covid cases seemed to be under control and like many other places, many restrictions were lifted and in January schools were once again allowed to resume in-person learning. Unfortunately, in March, due to increased cases (worst wave so far), everything has shut back down and we have been forced to resume remote learning and adapt our church services and ministry efforts. This is very difficult given the poor internet connections and many who don't have access to computers. In March, Kenya received a supply of vaccines and has begun to offer vaccines for teachers, ministers, health officials etc. Our school was fortunate to get access to some of those vaccines and so Leah and I got our first dose of the AstraZeneca vaccine and Lord willing we hope to get our second dose in May. Please continue to pray that cases will get back under control and that access to vaccines will continue for the general population. Their way of life here in the crowded city does not include much of an option to isolate and most people work just to survive or feed their families. Unsanitary conditions also make it very difficult to fight the virus!



On a more positive note we are happy to share that Allison, Evan and Ethan have adapted tremendously well to the ever changing circumstances. They have made many new friends and have enjoyed learning both in-person and online. They have also enjoyed attending school and church in-person for a few months at least. It is really neat to see them interact with their friends and yes, even introduce new games with some of them!





Our ministry with ICF (International Christian Fellowship) has continued to grow since you last heard from us and in January we were able to launch a few new ministries which include a new children's ministry, worship ministry, prayer ministry and discipleship ministry. We had our first SALT (Sunday Afternoon Leadership Training) courses and had great participation! We currently meet on the school's campus. Please continue to pray for ICF and for our newly formed ministry team as we seek to grow the ministry and outreach of this congregation in this dark city. Covid has really made progress difficult, but the Lord continues to show us His faithfulness and we must be obedient in His calling to spread the gospel and disciple believers!







Teachers come from all over the world to serve at Rosslyn.
