**Put the plant name in the photo filename.**

**For example:** Cym. Tower of Fire 'Anya' HCC/AOS B/CSA.jpg

**REQUIRED:**

1. Plant full name and Parents
2. Mother plant (MP), Meristem (MS)
3. Donated plant (yes/no)
4. Type (Standard, Novelty, Miniature, or species), and habit (upright, arching, or pendent)
5. Descriptive information (color, flower size & shape, fragrance, preferred growing conditions, etc.)
6. If in spike, specify # of spikes
7. If in bloom, specify approximately when flowers started opening
8. Specify if CymMV/ORSV tested with negative result within 3 months of submission date (Y or N)
9. Pot size: 1 gal, 2 gal, 5 inch, etc.
10. Division size: # GB (green bulbs), # BB (back bulbs), # G (new growths)

**OPTIONAL:**

1. Seller's Estimated Value (SEV). The club recommends providing a non-binding "Seller's Estimated Value" to inform buyers on plant value, in the absence of a live auctioneer.
2. Sellers Minimum Bid (SMB) and yes/no on Reverse Bidding.
