General Description of Duties

The teachers are the heart of TCA. They have a desire to share their love of Jesus through instructing students about Himself and His creation. The teacher's role combines curriculum and instruction; relationship with students, families, and colleagues; and a willingness to grow professionally. The Logic Stage is a key part of the classical student's development. During this stage, the student learns to ask good questions, to make new connections, and to draw logical conclusions. An effective Logic School instructor must guide a student to these skills, providing ample opportunities to stretch thinking in the classroom and at home. As the leaders of TCA's classrooms, teachers are responsible to deliver daily instruction with a vision of creating a culture of grace and excellence in their classrooms.

Additionally, all faculty members at Trinity Classical Academy are expected to demonstrate:

- Love for Christ: Applying His word to our work
- Love for others: Winning hearts to teach content
- Love for learning: Building a "make it better" culture of reflection and humility

Responsibilities

- Demonstrate appropriate planning and preparation for instruction; write effective and clear lesson plans for campus and home instruction
- Develop and maintain a classroom atmosphere that inspires learning and engages students in age-appropriate, logic-level, classical instruction and discussion
- Communicate consistently, truthfully and graciously with students and co-teaching parents
- Set and communicate measurable objectives for students to move towards mastery
- Assess students both formally and informally; communicate results with students and co-teachers in a timely manner and reflect results in their quarterly grade reports
- Maintain an orderly classroom, taking care of curricula and equipment belonging to TCA
- Encourage students to uphold the school-wide READ rules by setting and maintaining expectations with regards to classroom behavior; embody these rules with your own conduct during the school day
- Honor the confidentiality of school and student information
- Authentically engage in self-reflection, moving toward TCA's standards of "being the curriculum," being a team, teaching intentionally, and teaching integratedly
- Comply with policies and procedures as articulated in TCA Faculty Handbook
- Perform other duties as directed by the Director
