Mrs. Schnetzer's Homework Policy

Homework

We will only give homework to practice skills learned during the day. We ask that you spend your evenings doing things to promote student success: play outside, eat dinner as a family, play board games and card games, and get your child to bed early.

Parents have the control: If the student is frustrated or unable to finish their homework, the student gets full credit as long as we get a note from a parent. Students still may be asked to work with us to get some extra quality time to help them understand!

<u>Planners are a tool to help organize students and add communication!</u>

Each night, the student will bring home a planner. Spelling words will be listed as well as important events in the classroom/school/district. You can use this as a communication book between us!

If we give homework, it will consist of work your student did not complete during the day.

- Homework counts for ten percent of the final grade in any given subject.
- Homework assignments are expected to be written by the student in the student planner. The planner should be brought home and then back to school the following day.
- The homework should be brought home and then back to school the following day in the homework folder.
- If there is a reason why the child was unable to complete the assignment, a note needs to be written by the parent to excuse the child for his/her lateness and brought to school on the day that the assignment is due. The assignment will then be made up that night without penalty.
- If there is an unexcused missed assignment, a note will be sent home and signed by a parent or guardian. The assignment must be completed and brought in with the signed note on the following day. Half credit will be given for the assignment.
- Any assignment that is more than one day late will not be given any credit.
- If a student has missed school, the assignment missed will be assigned at the discretion of the teacher.

Mrs. Schnetzer's Vacation Policy

If a student is taken out of school for a vacation, missed work will not be given prior to the vacation. When the student returns, missed work will be assigned and will be due in the same number of days that the student was absent from school.
