This story is described in the third person and this story is mainly about a man named Butch who is stronger than others. He charges people to enter the playground because he is stronger than others. It is a very wonderful fate, just as the Chinese saying goes, from an exchange of blows friendship grows, Adam's cleverness not only allows everyone to freely enter the playground again, but also gain a new friend. I think this sentence is not only a sentence that makes them truly turn enemies into friends, but also means that Butch is not that bad. Adam not only doesn't care how Butch treats him, but he is willing to be friends with him in the end. This friendship really touched me.

This story describes the spirit of never giving up for justice. Although it is not a very long novel, it still has a lot of meaning in it. I admire Adam's spirit very much, he did not flinch because he was shorter and smaller than Butch, but bravely stood up to confront him, this spirit is really worth learning.

After reading this story, I think on the other hand, it can also let everyone know and pay attention to the seriousness of bullying again, although this is just a story, bullying still exists in our lives. When we encounter bullying or see it, we should stand up, not be afraid, and try to make the world free from bullying.

What fascinated me at the end of the whole story is that Adam and Butch ended up being good friends, maybe Butch was bad, maybe we all did little bad things, but as long as we don't commit crimes again, the friends around us will gradually increase. This friendship from enemies to friends is good. This is really a great story.
