How to Submit a Complaint about pinning Paywalled art to Pinterest

- 1. Open the 'Features and Settings' menu. Click 'pins' and scroll down. Click continue to move on.
- 2. Select 'Something Else' as the issue.
- 3. Fill in your account information, then continue.
- 4. Describe the issue. You may copy & paste the script below.
 - a. Subject
 - i. Why can I use the Pinterest Extension on Paywalled Art?
 - b. Description
 - i. It has come to my attention that Pinterest is allowing people to pin artworks to their boards that are behind Patreon paywalls. I have tested this with the permission of an artist and have found that I can pin their paywalled art with the Pinterest Save Button Extension. You cannot get behind the paywall from the link, but you can see the artwork without paying for it, meaning that one person can pay for a subscription and share that art without the artist's consent. Pinterest should block Patreon links immediately and remove all posts that link to Patreon to protect independent creators and their interests.
- 5. Select the option for 'pin already on Pinterest' and use the link to this board I created for this purpose.

- 6. Continue to the next section. Your device and browser should auto-populate, but if not choose the correct options and continue.
- 7. Select the 'No error message' option and continue.
- 8. Add this video file to the report.

- a. COMPRESSED Pinterest/Patreon Test Video
- b. This file was compressed because Pinterest only accepts files of a certain size. This should work, but if not contact me through Instagram or Twitter.
- c. You will have to download it as Pinterest does not accept cloud/drive files.
- 9. Continue to the next section and submit your request. Pinterest will send you an autoreply email.
 - a. You may reply to this email to speak to a representative, but I'm not sure how effective this is.
