## Dear Families,

Welcome to the Fourth Grade!! We are very excited to have your student for the next school year!

During Step-Up Day today we had the opportunity to meet and discuss classroom procedures for the upcoming school year. We also discussed all the wonderful new knowledge the students will gain in Fourth Grade. We would like to take a moment and share some of these procedures with you:

Every child will have an assignment sheet they get every week. They will record assignments here. You will be asked to check this to make sure classwork and homework is getting completed.

On Fridays, your child will bring home a weekly folder. This has different titles per each individual teacher, but the concept is the same. The folder will contain his/her graded work and a behavior report. Please sign and return this every Monday. This is an excellent way for us to communicate our thoughts and concerns with each other.

The fourth grade will discuss class rules together during the first days of school. A copy of these will then be sent home for you to review, sign, and return. A copy will also be placed in the classroom as a helpful reminder.

Finally, we strongly encourage your child to regularly READ over the summer. Practicing and memorizing multiplication and division facts are another skill that would benefit your child and provide a strong foundation for 4th grade math.


