A good way to learn more about individuals who played a role in our nation's history during the late 1800s and early 1900s is to search for information on the internet. For the search to be effective, however, certain steps need to be followed:

Identify the topic – the topic is what you want to learn more about Develop key search terms – these are the terms that you will do a search for Conduct a search – type the key search terms into the internet search field Once you type in your key search terms, you will get many different results. The next step is to narrow your search even further. Choose the sites that you actually use with care. Many websites offer different points of view or provide incomplete or inaccurate information. Websites with .edu and .gov are generally accurate because they are run by schools or the government. Other reliable sites include ones that end .org. These are organizations. Many organizations provide useful and factual information.
