

# Senior Project Q and A

**Q: When do my hours have to be completed?**

A: Hours will be completed during the month of May, starting May 4th.

**Q: Can I create my own business or learn a new skill?**

A: No, you must pick between the 2 senior project options as listed in the SP guidelines.

- 1) Explore a career field of interest to you
- 2) Engage in service learning or volunteer at a non-profit

**Q: Where do I find the forms that need to be submitted by my supervisor?**

A: On your Google Site

**Q: How do I access my Google Site?**

A: Your team leader shared it with you. Go to drive and search "Senior Project. "

**Q: Can I work with a family Member?**

A: No, you cannot for a family member.

**Q: Can I do all my hours virtually?**

A: No, you can only do 10 hours virtually. 40 hours must be in a physical workplace.

**Q: Can me and (so and so) work together?**

A: No, you must complete your hours on your own.

**Q: Can I start my hours early?**

A: Short answer: yes, but only over spring break (up to 25 hours). You must fill out a form and get approval if you choose this option. Long answer: the month of May is set aside for APs and Senior Projects.

**Q: How am I going to fit in 50 hours?**

A: This is what the CALENDAR is for on your Google Site. Plan around your APs and other commitments.

**Q: When is my presentation scheduled?**

A: Based on the last day that you have put down on your calendar, your team leader will schedule your presentation.

**Q: Can my service hours count towards my senior project and vice versa?**
