

Cranberry Scholarship Application

Cranberry USA, a generous dental supply company, is looking for pre-dental and pre-dental hygiene students who share a passion and enthusiasm for bringing dental care to those in need.

Scholarship Details:

- 1. Successful applicants will receive a \$750 scholarship to be used towards the cost of project fees for a GDR trip to Cambodia, Nepal, India, Guatemala, Mexico or Kenya.
- 2. Recipients will be responsible for remaining trip costs and their airfare to the project location.
- 3. Successful applicants will be required to submit a post trip report and short video clips as well as photos of their experience within 30 days of trip completion. Specific requirements will be supplied to scholarship recipients.
- 4. Cranberry will award an additional \$250 cash to any scholarship student who returns to the US and is accepted to dental or hygiene school.

Application Process:

- 1. Eligible applicants include current pre-dental students, pre-dental hygiene students and recent college graduates who are applying to dental school.
- 2. Interested applicants should complete the Cranberry Scholarship application and submit to Global Dental Relief. Interested applicants must agree to reporting requirements requested by Cranberry and provide deliverables within 30 days of project completion.
- 3. Scholarship decisions will be made within 30 days of receipt. If approved, applicants will work with GDR staff to select a suitable date and location for service.
