1. The word and word #
2. The book title and pg # in the book where you found the word
3. The word in context (the sentence the word was in from the book)
4. Part of speech
5. Synonym(s), if there are any
6. Antonym(s), if there are any
7. Your description of the word ([How Do I Write a Word Description?](#))
8. An example sentence, written by you, showing that you understand the word
9. Picture
