

Scholarship List November 2025

1. **Stephen J. Brady Stop Hunger Scholarship:** The Stephen J. Brady Stop Hunger Scholarship recognizes students, ages 5 to 25, who are tackling hunger in their communities. Applicants should demonstrate creativity, leadership and impact in fighting food insecurity. National scholars receive a \$10,000 academic scholarship and a \$5,000 grant for their hunger-relief charity. They also attend the Sodexo Charity Classic, where they have the opportunity to connect with industry leaders who support the Stop Hunger mission. **The deadline to apply is November 5, 2025.** Apply at <https://www.us.stop-hunger.org/grants/youth-scholarships>.
2. **Elks most valuable student scholarship:** Ranging from \$1,000 per year to \$7,500 per year, Most Valuable Student scholarships are for students pursuing a four-year degree, on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 semester hours), in a U.S. college or university. **Application deadline is November 12.** Apply at <https://www.elks.org/scholars/scholarships/mvs.cfm>.
3. **Jack Kent Cooke Foundation College Scholarship:** The Cooke Foundation College Scholarship Program is the largest undergraduate scholarship program available to high-achieving high school seniors with financial need who seek to attend the nation's best four-year colleges and universities. In addition to the monetary award, Cooke Scholars receive comprehensive educational advising, significant cohort-based programming, and graduate school funding, as well as a thriving network of nearly 3,200 fellow Cooke Scholars and Alumni. 4. **10 Words or less Scholarship:** \$1000 Scholarship for a high school Senior who explains in 10 words or less why they deserve the \$1000 scholarship. More information is found at <https://scholarshipguidance.com/scholarships/27926/10-words-or-less-scholarship>. **The deadline to apply is November 15.**
5. **Ron Brown Scholar Program:** \$10,000 annually for 4 years. Guidelines: must be Black/African American; must excel academically; must exhibit exceptional leadership potential; must participate in community service activities; demonstrate financial need; be a US citizen or hold a permanent resident visa card; be a current high school senior at the time of your application. **Deadline to apply is December 1;** more information at <https://ronbrown.org/apply/ron-brown-scholarship/> .
6. **Hagan Scholarship:** This scholarship provides \$7500 each semester for up to 8 consecutive semesters. The requirements are that you must have a 3.50 GPA or higher and have financial need. More information and an application can be found at <https://haganscholarships.org/>. Scholarship brochures can be found in Student Services. **The deadline to apply is December 1, 2025.**
7. **Science Ambassador Scholarship:** The Science Ambassador Scholarship is a \$20,000 scholarship for a **woman** in science, technology, engineering, or math. You must film a three-minute educational video of yourself explaining a STEM topic you're passionate about. The application is found here at <https://www.scienceambassadorscholarship.org/>. **The deadline to apply is December 15, 2025.**

8. **Dr. Juan Andrade Jr. Scholarship:** The \$1000 Dr. Juan Andrade Jr. Scholarship is for young Hispanic Leaders; it seeks to recognize Hispanic students who share Dr. Andrade's lifelong commitment to servant leadership. At least one parent must be of Hispanic ancestry. There is a required Essay and recommendation letters needed.
