Boys and girls, husbands and wives, relatives and friends also give presents and sweets to each other.

Halloween

Halloween is celebrated on the 31st of October. Halloween is time for fun. It is very dear to children and teenagers. They put on costumes of ghosts and witches. Small

children go to “Trick or treat”, tell scary stories, and watch horror films. The traditional decoration is Jack-o-lantern. People cut holes in the pumpkin and put a candle inside it. Pumpkin pie is traditionally on the table.
