Special Note: I used the Gather Together stamp set and Gathered Leaves Dies thinking they were in the annual catalog, since they did carry over from the 2019 Holiday Catalog. They actually will return in the 2020 Holiday Catalog on August 1. You can get them a month earlier on July 1 by joining my team of My Joyful Stampers, plus get a discount! Read more here.

- 1. Fold in half at  $4-\frac{1}{4}$ " a  $5-\frac{1}{2}$ " x8- $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece of Shaded Spruce cardstock.
- 2. Use the blade of a pair of Paper Snips to lightly distress the edges of a 5-1/4"x4" piece of Shaded Spruce cardstock. **Tip:** to lightly distress, run the open blade of the Paper Snips along the paper's edges. Repeat this until you get the distressed look you desire. Glue the panel to the card base with Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
- 3. Cut from Pear Pizzazz cardstock the largest circle from the Stitched Shapes Dies. Glue to the card with Multipurpose Liquid Glue, with some of the circle hanging over the card edges. Trim overhang with Paper Snips.
- 4. Use a sponge dauber to apply Coastal Cabana ink to the largest leaf image from the Gather Together set. Use another sponge dauber to apply Pear Pizzazz ink to the leaf image. Use a third sponge dauber to apply Shaded Spruce ink to the leaf image. "Huff" or breathe on the inked image and stamp on a 5-¼"x4" piece of Very Vanilla cardstock in the lower left corner. Attach to the inside of the card with Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
- 5. Repeat the inking technique on the same stamp image from Step 4 and stamp on a piece of Very Vanilla cardstock. Cut leaf using Gathered Leaves Dies. Attach with Stampin' Dimensionals to stitched circle on card.
- 6. **Note:** I mistakenly used a wooden element from a retired package, however the following technique will work the same with the current product and both pieces are similar. Smoosh a Versamark ink pad on a wooden leaf spray from In Good Taste Elements. Sprinkle on White Stampin' Emboss Powder and melt with a Heat Tool. Use a Dark Granny Apple Green Stampin' Blends to outline the wooden embossed embellishment (drawing on the melted powder will not hurt your Blends). Attach to card with Mini Glue Dot.
- 7. Tie a bow with Linen Thread and attach to In Good Taste embellishment with Mini Glue Dot.

- 8. Cut 3 leaves from Shaded Spruce cardstock using Gathered Leaves Dies. Attach to card with Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Use your fingers to curl up the leaf edges.
- 9. Stamp sentiment in Shaded Spruce ink on card.
