## Volunteer Internship: Animal Care and Outreach Specialist

### Duties

- Animal Care
  - Feeding and Watering
  - Prepare food items (e.g., frozen/thawed prey items) via best practices and safety standards
  - Deliver food items to animals via best practices and safety standards
  - Ensure animals have clean, fresh water
  - Check well-being of animals and be able to recognize signs of ill-health
  - Assist director with health-related activities (e.g., veterinarian visits, weighing birds)
  - Habitat Maintenance
  - Clean and sanitize habitats and related items on a regular schedule
  - Maintain a clean and sanitary work space
  - Participate in animal enrichment and exercise activities as needed
  - Stay current on avian, reptile, and invertebrate knowledge and care
  - Help staff programs, booths, and presentations (prep supplies, transfer animals, set up, and more)
  - Participate in presentations with animal ambassadors
  - Represent Nature's Educators to the public and clients
  - Network with Nature's Educators volunteers and partners
