Using Reusable Food Wares

One thing that cannot be separated from our lives is food. We need to eat and consume food to regain energy for our activities. Several people have time to cook and serve food by themselves, while others can by food to be served in their dining tables. When people tend to by food from food stalls or restaurants, they have to use plastics as the food wrapping. Can you imagine how many plastics used in a day just for food wrapping?

Wrapping food using plastics can affect our environment, because those plastics are not reusable or only being used once. When plastics are burned after being used, whether to produce electric supply or to eliminate them, the residues are dangerous. The ash from the burning is poisonous to the water and the soil. The fog and smog from burning process contain metal polluting the air and it is dangerous to breathe in

Then, plastics are made of chemicals. Plastics used for storing or wrapping food should be food friendly which are made for the purpose. These kinds of plastics are not dangerous for the food inside of them when they get heated. For example, when you want to buy gravy food to take away, which is fresh from the pan, the seller will wrap it using plastic. However, are you sure that the plastic is safe to be used at high temperature? How about being used at low temperature such as for iced tea?

For those reasons, we should consider to use reusable food wares. We can start using our own bottles for our favorite beverages and consider to use stainless or glass straws, instead of plastic ones. We can bring our own food containers or boxes whenever we order take-away food. Those reusable food wares are not as cheap as plastics, but they can be used over and over. Let's care for our environment by using reusable containers.
