NARRATIVE REPORT
Acceptance of Donated Printer from SK Dalig to PIHS SSLG

I. Introduction

In support of collaborative partnerships between youth organizations and educational institutions, and in line with the provisions of Republic Act No. 10742 (Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015), which encourages youth participation in community development and inter-organizational cooperation, as well as Republic Act No. 8044 (Youth in Nation-Building Act), the Sangguniang Kabataan of Barangay Dalig extended assistance to the Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG) of Pantay Integrated High School (PIHS) through the donation of a printer intended to support student leadership operations and school-related activities.
