SSWSC Event Fact Sheet

For The 20TH ANNUAL JULY 4TH SKI JUMPING EXTRAVAGANZA

June 28th – July 4th, 2025

GENERAL INFO: - This fun for the entire family event will showcase our nation's top ski jumping and nordic combined athletes as well as top club performers from around the country in a fun atmosphere with music, food, and festive activities for all to enjoy. This annual event is currently the only summer ski jumping/nordic combined competition held in Steamboat Springs, the state of Colorado, or the Rocky Mountain Division.

LOCATION: - Howelsen Hill Ski Jumping Complex, Steamboat Springs, Colorado.

COMPETITION FORMAT: - This year's competition will feature three events: The first is a standard trial and two-to-count ski jumping competition on the HS8, HS45, and HS75 meter ski jumps. The second is a Nordic Combined Sprint event with a 1km (HS8 & HS45) run, then a 3km roller-ski race (HS75) each down Lincoln Ave just before the July 4th parade. The third event is an Elimination Jump on the HS75 right after the parade.

OPEN TRAINING: - Please see [Schedule of Events](#) for open training dates and times. Teams must pre-schedule training at least 5 days in advance by email to: (twilson@sswsc.org). Hill fees for training before June 28th or after July 4th are \$40 per day (payable to SSWSC). Hill & lift fees for June 28th through July 4th are included in the entry fee (see below).

JUMP EVENTS: - **Thursday, July 3rd:** Jumping competition begins at **8:30 a.m.** on the HS8 with the HS75/45 immediately following. There will be a half hour open training session from 8:00 - 8:30 on the HS8 only, then two to count beginning at 8:30. Event format will be a trial & two-to-count, with both jumps counting for NC for U10, U12's. The first jump will count for the NC sprint for U14, U16, U20, and Sr. class. **Friday, July 4th:** HS75 Elimination Jump beginning at **10:50 a.m.** with the national anthem followed by the first round with all jumpers at **11:00**. After the first round, the field will be cut to the round of 32, then 16, then 8, then 4. Winner will be determined from the round of 4. The top four will receive prize money as will the top female and there will be a \$100 bonus for the longest jump in the rounds of 32, 16 and 8.

NC RACES: - **Friday, July 4th:** **9:15 a.m.** start, U10 (HS8/1km), U12, U14 (HS45/1km) running races. **9:30 a.m.** start, U16, U20, Sr. (HS75), 3km roller ski race. Both races will be on Lincoln Ave. just before the 4th of July parade. **All races will be Gundersen start with start/finish at 8th and Yampa.**

CLASSES: - HS8/U10, HS45, two classes, U12 & U14 for men and women, SJ & NC. On the HS75 there will be three classes for men and women, SJ & NC: U16, U20, and Senior class. Athletes can only jump their age class and one class up. The elimination jump on the 4th is one class.

OLYMPIAN HALL: - Olympian Hall (OH) will be available all week to athletes and coaches as a changing and staging area as well as a meeting room and competition headquarters for the events. No physical activities other than stretching in OH, please. OH is not to be used as an overnight storage area. Please keep OH picked up and remove all belongings each day. We also kindly ask that only SSWSC members use the SSWSC locker room. No ski storage is provided on-site at Howelsen Hill Ski Area. Please plan accordingly and let us know if you need assistance.

WEDNESDAY EVENING BBQ: On Wednesday evening, the SSWSC will host a cookout outside Olympian Hall from 6:30 to 8:00 for athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers, and parents. Burgers, brats, dogs, buns, water/lemonade and paper plates, cups, and plastic ware will be provided. SSWSC families, and any others that would like, are asked to bring a dish, salad, or dessert to share. Folding/camp chairs encouraged. A donation jar will be set up for extra family members.

ENTRY FEES: - Visiting teams: \$250 for the HS8, \$300 for HS45 or \$350 for HS75. **Entry fee includes hill fees, lift fees, and entry fees from Friday, June 28th through Thursday, July 4th, Wednesday BBQ and an athlete gift.** SSWSC registered athletes pay \$110 for HS8, \$135 for the HS45 and \$180 for the HS75 as hill and lift fees are paid with club program fees. The entry fee is payable to the SSWSC. National Team Members: "A" Team is comped for all fees, "B" Team pays half, "C" Team and lower pay full fees.

REGISTRATION: - Team leaders, please fill out the entry form for your team by **Entry Deadline: 12:00 noon, Monday, June 30th**. An entry form link will be sent out to team leaders.

Seeding: Four seeds will be used on the HS75 & HS45 in each class and must be entered with registration. The first seed will be reserved for the US National Teams only. Each team should divide their skiers evenly in seeds two, three and four. Seed four will jump in the first group, seed three will jump second, seed two will jump next, and the first seed (National Teams) will jump last.

SSWSC WAIVER: A SSWSC waiver must be signed but only **once a year** (May 1st to April 30th) by athletes 18 & over or by parents for athletes under 18. See link for SmartWaiver [here](#).

HOWELSEN HILL JUMPING FACILITY USE AGREEMENT and RELEASE: The Howelsen Hill Magic Carpet will be open for all training and competitions. In place of wearing a lift ticket each day, this waiver must be signed by each user 18 & over or by a parent if under 18. See link for Smart Waiver [here](#).
