

Parent Access to Student Library Resources

Stay Connected to Your Child's Library Experience

At Cranfills Gap ISD, we believe families are important partners in helping students develop a lifelong love of reading and learning. Follett Destiny provides parents and guardians with tools to stay informed about their child's library activity and personalize their library experience.

Through parent access, you can view your child's current library checkouts, search the library collection, and manage titles you do not wish your child to check out.

Who Can Access These Features?

To use Destiny's parent features, your email address must be connected to your student in Destiny Library Manager.

Please note: Each student can be connected to only one parent or guardian email address for these features. The email address associated with the student's primary guardian will be used for access.

Getting Started

Step 1: Visit the Parent Verification Page

Click the link below to open the Follett Destiny Parent Verification page.

Step 2: Enter Your Email Address

Enter the parent or guardian email address associated with your student's account. Then select Get Access Code.

Having trouble? If Destiny does not recognize your email address, the address may not match the one in Destiny or may not currently be connected to a student. Please contact Cranfills Gap ISD for assistance.

Check Your Email for Your Access Code

After selecting Get Access Code, check your email for a message from no-reply@follettlearning.com with the subject line "Additional User Type Access Code."

Important: Your access code is valid for 10 minutes. If it expires, select Resend Code and request another one.

Step 3: Enter Your Access Code

1. Enter the access code you received by email.
2. If you're using a trusted personal device and would like to remain signed in, select Keep me logged in on this device.
3. Select Submit.

If you choose to remain logged in, Destiny will keep you signed in on that browser for 60 days or until you log out. Otherwise, you'll need to request an access code each time you sign in.

Explore Your Parent Library Features

Search the Library

Search the collection by title, author, or subject. From the search results, you can view additional information about a book or choose to block a title from being checked out.

View Current Checkouts

Select Checkouts to see the library materials your child currently has checked out. You can also select View More Details for additional information about a title.

Manage Blocked Titles

Parents and guardians can identify individual titles they do not want their child to check out. Select Blocked to see the titles you have previously blocked. If you change your mind, use the menu beside a title to remove the block. You can also select View More Details to learn more about a particular title.

More Than One Student?

If more than one student is associated with your email address, Destiny will provide a drop-down menu so you can select the student whose library information you would like to view.

When You're Finished

Select Logout when you are ready to end your Destiny session, particularly when using a shared or public computer.
