

Privacy Policy for Image Tape

Effective date: Sep 3, 2026

On-device image processing

Image Tape composes selected images on your device. Selected images, exported images, screenshots, file names, file-system paths or URIs, and EXIF and per-image metadata are not sent to the Image Tape feedback endpoint.

Optional feedback and issue reports

Opening the feedback flow creates a diagnostic snapshot on the device but does not upload it. Data is sent only when you explicitly tap Send report. A report contains:

- Your feedback or issue description, up to 500 characters
- A random report ID, snapshot capture time, server receipt time, and report trigger
- App ID, version and build; platform, OS version, language, device manufacturer and model
- Current screen, route and navigation hierarchy; workflow state, image count and selected position
- Planned PNG dimensions and estimates, export stage and progress, available primary actions, and the last primary action with its timestamp
- Up to 100 recent error identifiers: sequence, time, source-location ID, severity, code and name

The structured report does not include image or screenshot data, asset URIs, item IDs, file-system paths, error-message bodies, stack traces, advertising IDs, account IDs, contacts, device names, precise location, or raw motion-sensor samples. If you type personal, confidential, file-path, or other sensitive information in the feedback field, it will be sent as part of your message; please do not include it.

Purpose and storage

We use submitted data only to reproduce issues, support users, and improve Image Tape. Reports are transmitted over HTTPS through Google Apps Script and stored in Google Sheets. The report Sheet is not publicly shared. There is no automatic retention period: reports remain until the operator manually deletes them, including after processing a verified deletion request.

Local diagnostics

Recent diagnostic errors are kept only in app memory, up to 100 entries. When full, the oldest 50 entries are removed. The iOS shake gesture uses motion-sensor samples only to detect the gesture; raw samples are not stored or transmitted.

Data sharing and security

We do not sell submitted report data. It is disclosed only to the Google services used to receive and store reports, to people the Sheet owner explicitly authorizes, or when legally required. The write endpoint does not provide an app-facing API for reading stored reports.

Your choices and deletion

Sending a report is optional. To request deletion, email maakcode@gmail.com with the text you submitted, the approximate submission time, and the app and OS versions. We use only the minimum information needed to verify the request and locate the report. Do not post report contents or personal information in a public issue tracker.

Changes to this policy

If the collected fields, purpose, or retention practice changes, this document will be updated with a new effective date. Material changes will also be described in the app-store version history when appropriate.
