Please *memorize* and be prepared to perform one of the two following monologues. Gender does not matter. When you are called into the room to audition, be prepared to introduce yourself and say which monologue you have prepared (Example: "Hi, my name is Sally Smith and I will be performing Myron's monologue.) When you are finished, the director might ask you questions or ask to you make adjustments and do the monologue again. Be loud and be expressive! Show us what you've got!

LESLIE
