EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULEBOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

1. **LEVELS:** Intro Level through Grand Prix, USEF Eventing TOC, Dressage Seat Equitation, Para- Equestrian and Freestyles.

2. **AWARDS:** Ribbons to sixth place.

3. **ENTRIES/FEES:**

Intro Level- Second Level: \$60 per class

Third Level- Fourth Level: \$70 per class

FEI Prix St. George- Grand Prix: \$80 per class

Musical Freestyles: \$80 per class

Dressage Seat Equitation: \$60 per class

Para-Equestrian: \$80 per class

USEF Eventing TOC: \$60 per class

USEF Drug Fee: \$23 per horse

GAIG/USDF Qualifying: \$20 per eligible class

Office Fee: \$50 per entry (non-refundable)

Incomplete Entry Fee: \$30

Post Entry Surcharge: \$50 (applies to all entries **received** after closing date)

Entry/Class change Fee: \$30 per class

USDF Non-Member Fee: \$55

USEF Show Pass: must be applied for through USEF website directly

Limited stabling: \$300 per stall

Shavings: \$15 per bag

Non-compete horse: \$50 per horse

**NO REFUNDS AFTER CLOSING DATE OR FOR 'ACTS OF GOD' WHICH REQUIRE MANAGEMENT TO CANCEL CLASSES OR DAY(S) OF COMPETITION.**

**Freestyle music must be emailed by closing date!**

**ALL ENTRIES MUST INCLUDE: Proof of negative Coggins dated within 12 months of the show, proof of EIV and EHV vaccinations dated within 6 months of the show, a \$23 USEF drug fee and a \$50 office per day!** Each entry must include three signatures. Make checks payable to Puckerbrush Farm. Entries will be accepted through **mail, email**, or online via **HorseShowOffice.com**

4. **TIMES:** Times will be available at least one week prior to the competition on our website – [www.puckerbrushfarm.net](http://www.puckerbrushfarm.net) and [www.horseshowoffice.com](http://www.horseshowoffice.com). Ride times will be available to exhibitors by noon the day prior to start of competition.

Soundcheck for Musical Freestyles will tentatively be conducted the day prior to the class at a time to be announced.

5. **FOOTING:** 2 sand/fiber blend arenas. All tests will be in a standard sized arena (20mx60m) except para classes which will be in a small sized arena (20mx40m). Warm-up will be in a 150'x125' sand/polyester blend ring.

6. **STABLING:** 18, permanent, 10ft.x12ft. stalls with full doors on grounds. Early postmarked, completed entry will receive priority. Stalls available Thursday after 1pm until Sunday 5pm. \$300 per stall. **BLOCK STABLING ONLY!** Tack stalls if space allows, same rate. **NO ARRIVALS AFTER 8PM!!** You must supply your own bedding. **Stall must be left clean!**

7. **SHARPS CONTAINERS:** Competition management shall place a minimum of one sharps container per each competition. Additionally, at least one sharps container per fifty occupied stalls for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments in convenient locations in barns housing competition horses.
8. **DIRECTIONS:** From *South*: North on I-95, Exit 167 (Etna-Dixmont-previously Exit 42). Turn left on Rt. 143 towards Dixmont. Go approx. 5.5 miles to sharp corner. Turn left onto Miles Rd. Go approx 2.5 miles and Puckerbrush is on the right. From *North*: South on I-95, Exit 174 (Carmel-Winterport-previously Exit 43). Turn left onto Rt. 69 towards Winterport. At blinking light, turn right onto Rt. 202/9. Go approx 4.7 miles and just over crest of hill turn right onto Miles Rd. Puckerbrush is .5 miles on left.
9. **FOOD:** A variety of food will be provided.
10. **OTHER:** Vet on call- Foxcroft Large Animal Vet- 207.717.3023 Farrier on call- Erica Toothaker 207.478.0866. Closest equine surgical care- Annabessacook Veterinary 207-933-2165. Numbers will be posted at the secretary's booth and in the show program. **NO DOGS ALLOWED ON SHOW GROUNDS. Any changes in classes, scratches, or cancellations without 24 hours notice or on the day of the show are subject to a \$30 office fee.**
