

South Sanpete School District's
Digital Citizenship Plan

The District's plan asks all teachers to provide age-appropriate digital citizenship to all students. The District has identified a monthly focus and will provide instructional resources.

PRINCIPALS:

- Provide staff with explicit instructions to implement digital citizenship.
- Develop a school-level plan to ensure all students receive age-appropriate instruction.

TEACHERS:

- Teach digital citizenship using monthly resources provided by the district and/or other quality resources.
- Model responsible behavior with technology and discuss how to stay safe on the internet. This happens consistently in the classroom setting where iPads are used.

STUDENTS:

- Sign the Acceptable Use Policy before being assigned an iPad. Teachers discuss the document so students fully understand how to use a device with utmost care.

DISTRICT EVENT

- **White Ribbon Week** - Schools focus on digital safety during the last week of February on an annual basis. Student councils are encouraged to be involved.
