Estate - describes a relationship between a person and property 1 - Who owns it? 2- When do they own it? (Present interest, Future interest)

Types of Estates.

1 - Fee Simple
Josh owns it forever
Josh owns Blackare and when
Josh dies it goes to Josh's heirs.
Who owns it?
Present interest - Josh
Future interest - Josh's heirs
When Josh dies, heir's future
interest becomes present.

Josh sells Blackare to Landon. Present interest - Landon

Future interest - Landon's heirs

ALienable - can transfer

Blackacre to Josh and his heirs.

Present Interest - Josh has
present till I die

Future interest - Josh's heirs has
future interest.

-- JOsh dies
