I want to serve people who struggle with mental health and addiction. I want them to understand their minds, their problems, and the sources of these problems. I want them to realize that they have time to correct their issues to have the life they dream of, and that only their mental beliefs hold them back from achieving anything or stopping any addiction. They can overcome even the most compelling addiction if they are truly committed. The system is designed to make them slaves, putting thousands of distractions and destructive elements in front of them, leading to addiction, so they lose their mental control, their energy, and their hope. This makes it much easier to become like a mouse in a trap, never achieving the life they deserve or even daring to express what they believe or think differently. However, if they just understood that they can change this, unless they are some 80+ years old, it's never too late. I want them to understand that there are greater things in life than being addicted to 30 seconds of joy followed by 30 days of regret, and that in their world, there are good people who will help them, if only they truly want to help themselves because no one can help someone who doesn't want to help himself.

The type of clients I'm serving on social media are the persons who were trapped by addiction, including new forms of addiction, to the extent that their lives are just destroyed. They are no longer the persons they once were; their life is on fire, but still, they are fighting. They can sense the hope, and they never give up. I want to help them to make this little hope very great and ensure that they will destroy their addiction and their mental problems. Then, I will force them to rebuild their life in the way they always wanted it to be, and they become great, strong, and proud of their happiness and the effort it takes to make their life great again. They will destroy by themselves their mental, physical, and quotidian habits because they are good, great persons that we need to build a greater society and have a better life for our future children's lives without addiction or traps that were designed to make you miserable, enslaved to some nobody rich and powerful.

What excites me about these clients is very simple: it's the way they make me proud because I help good people. Even if I can only wake up just one person, it's great. Also, I want to be able to warn them before they even get trapped and say to them, "Hey, if you just do these mistakes, you will end up like a mouse in a trap, so stop and don't take this route because it's just a trap, a very bad trap to make you a slave who will make his future children slaves like him, and miserable like him, while watching the misery, suffering, and struggling of his parents and beloved ones." I want also to say to people who are already trapped that it's okay, and they can control their selves again and rebuild the life they want if they stop right now and begin to make some real changes that make them struggle to become greater and out of this trap. But at least they will change, and the suffering they endure is just the price of their old mistakes, so it's okay. They must be smiling, however, if they really want to become greater and have the life that they only dream of when they are really broken, addicted, and miserable, they will be very grateful for me showing them the real path to greatness instead of losing hope. Because they will suffer in both cases, the only difference is they were suffering from addiction, and I say to them, "Help suffer for greatness." It's better for you, your family, your beloved ones, and your future beloved ones. Also, I want them to really understand that if they have time, they have a

chance in life. Real ones just see the chance, believe it, be the kind of person who is ready to be burned in hell to pay the price of his previous mistakes and to become great. If you are ready to do that, you will find people who will help you and make it better for you. If you are the type of person who will just cry and do the same thing again, know what? I can't help you; in fact, I don't want you on my channel. Yes, those are some key points of my response.
