Sophie Turner

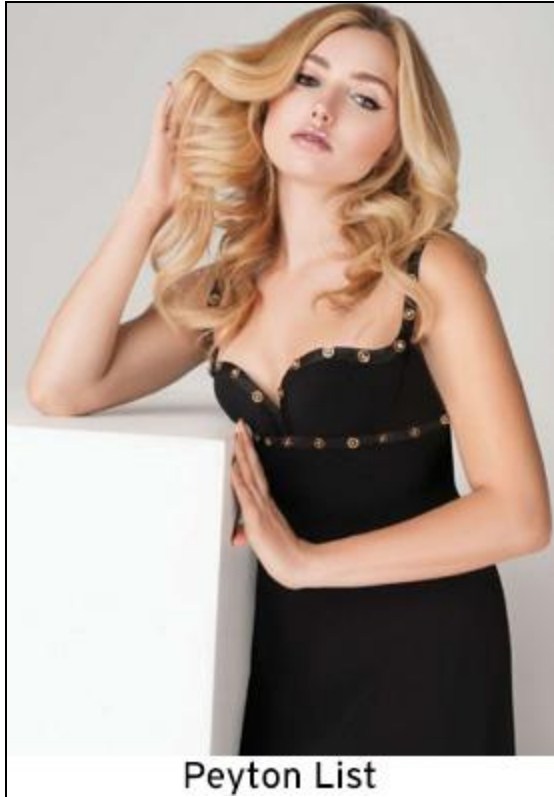

There were two bright lights in the lightweight division. Peyton List bounced back from her loss to Sherawat in London, by dominating the big-breasted Ourei Harada. First Time Winners in the UCC

Two Hellfire Girls with very different cage fighting histories recorded their first UCC wins in Chicago. With Gemma Atkinson and Debby Ryan securing virgin victories, Mr X now has every member of his 20 strong stable on the board with at least one win.

TKO Magazine reflects on their time as professional cage fighters.

Gemma Atkinson: The Pride of Manchester



Atkinson appeared in the very first issue of TKO, back in October 2011. It wasn't a great magazine debut, as she has just lost a match against Brainna Jordan. Although by the time TKO magazine started, Atkinson already had 30 professional fights to her name.

Later that month Atkinson won against Jana Delfi and celebrated by drinking pints of Guinness. She was already the Super Heavyweight champion and planned on never giving up that title.

At the next PPV (the only held once Queen of Champions event), Atkinson continued her winning ways with a tight victory against Bianca Gascoigne.

In February 2012 Atkinson made her first appearance as the cover girl of TKO. Touting as being 'unstoppable', Atkinson defeated Delfi once more in what would be part of an impressive winning streak. During the interview with TKO she stated that she was "Born to Own" the Lingerie tournament title.



At the first ever Hit the Beach tournament in April 2012, Atkinson fought her way to the final round. There she was defeated on points by Uma Thurman. Despite all her bravado, Atkinson held Thurman's hand aloft after the match. Thurman went on to praise her opponent during a TKO interview.

Atkinson bounced back from the Hit the Beach loss to knock out Danielle Lloyd at her next event, Tombstone. However Lloyd enacted her revenge at Blood on the Red Carpet, eliminating Atkinson in the first round. Atkinson's comments after the event were defiant, "She may have beaten me, but the bitch couldn't knock me out."



The back and forth battle with Lloyd continued at the next UMMA event, with Atkinson enacting her revenge with a ground and pound victory.

In July, 2012 the UMMA held a special event to coincide with the Olympic Games. Atkinson won four of five matches as was awarded a Gold Medal for inflicting injuries on other fighters!

By September 2012 Atkinson was a solid member of the all powerful RWB Group stable. There were high hopes from the stable owner as Atkinson battled her way to the finals of the first ever Lingerie Invitational.



Unfortunately Atkinson was unable to take the title belt, failing at the final hurdle to beat the very powerful Veronika Zemanova.

During the Open Fight Night in December, 2012, Atkinson wanted a rematch with Zemanova, but the fans set her up to face Maria Sharapova. A frustrated Atkinson lost that match by points. But even back then Atkinson and her RWB manager had their sights set on a new target: Kim Kardashian.

In May, 2013 Atkinson was still a dominating force in the Super Heavyweight division. However she was not alone. Her RWB stablemate Lucy Pinder was on the rise and the two of them met during the Honorbound event for a title fight. Pinder came away with a win, breaking Atkinson's cheekbone in the process. During the press conference Pinder said, "If I can stay injury-free, I genuinely believe that I can overtake her in the rankings."



Those words came back to haunt Pinder. At the Reality Check event in July, Atkinson KO'd Pinder by pulling her hair and reclaimed her title belt, keeping the lock of hair as a memento.

Not soon after this win Atkinson again failed to finish at the Lingerie Invitational. Bowing out in the third round with a loss against Peta Todd.

Revenge came for Atkinson when she broke Todd's ribs at their next meeting, defending her Super Heavyweight title in the process. Then at their next meeting a few months later, she did the same thing again. Defending her title and breaking Todd's ribs. Now 75 fights into her professional career, it seemed that no one could stop the British RWB fighter.

In March, 2014 Atkinson only managed to get to the third

round of the Hit the Beach tournament. Following that she got to the fourth round of the Red Carpet tournament and only the second round of the 2014 Lingerie Invitational. However, in between these tournaments she was fighting and defending her divisional title.

In July, 2015 Atkinson took on Kim Kardashian in the cage. She had been facing a lot of negative press over the preceding months. But a solid win against Kardashian gave her some relief as she commented, "Kim was on a six fight winning streak. I hope that by stopping her tonight, the press back home start to give me some credit."

In early 2016 (after some forgettable events) Atkinson once again destroyed Kardashian. Despite her tournament failures,



Atkinson had retained her title belt for one of the longest periods in the UMMA. At the conclusion of the event Atkinson openly questioned Kardashians eligibility for UMMA, pointing out that she has got to where she is today on account of her late lawyer father.

The next Red Carpet tournament was another set back for Atkinson, although she did bounce back with a title defence win against Sophie Howard at their next meeting.

Following closely from her win against Howard, the RWB stable disbanded. Atkinson was quickly snatched up by Mr X and the Hellfire Girls Club. The stable that should would stay until the end on the UMMA and then into the new era with the UCC.



It was with Hellfire that Atkinson won at the next Team Warfare event and then, finally, in February 2017 she won her first major tournament. Beating Torrie Wilson in the final round to claim the Lingerie Invitational belt.

But the victory there was only part of the story. Her feud with fellow HGC member Kim Kardashian blew up during these events. And as a result, Kardashian was forced to become Atkinsons intern for the entirety of 2017.

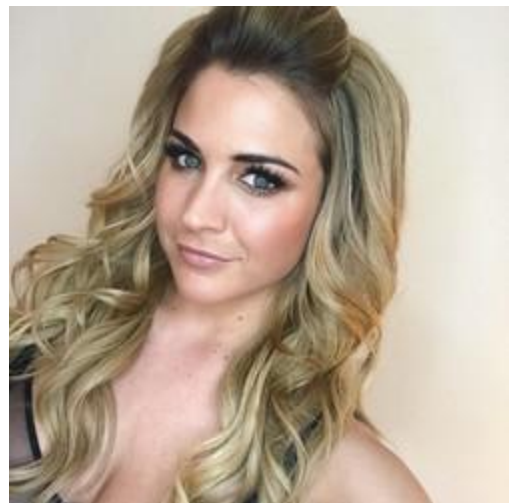
By March the internship was in full swing and was the talk of the UMMA and the MMA sporting world. Atkinson featured for the second time on the cover of TKO magazine.

This was a different Atkinson than we had met all those years ago. Gone was the Guinness. Now it was pumping iron and taking fitness to a new level. All with the reluctant aid of Kardashian.

Atkinson continued her domination of her division and Kardashian. The only slip being a 26 second loss to Kardashian at the Fury event in July, 2017.

As 2017 drew to a close, Atkinson defeated Kardashian to win back her title belt. The internship also came to an end. Although the rivalry between the two stablemates remained.

As 2018 began, there was turmoil in the Hellfire Girls Club stable. Mr X organized a huge battle royale in his London headquarters. Atkinson and Kardashian battled each other, until they both turned on Jennifer Lawrence. The fighting was physical and intense and several Hellfire girls were removed from the stable. Atkinson survived.



In the last of the standard UMMA events, Atkinson relinquished her Super Heavyweight title to Torrie Wilson. This was her 113th UMMA professional bout.

At the Red Carpet tournament in May, 2018 Atkinson failed to get past the second round. She was eliminated by her stablemate Deborah Ann Woll.

When the UMMA ended, Atkinson had competed in 166 fights and had won 83 of them. She had amassed 45 wins by Knockout, but only 3 wins by Submission. The tough girl that she is, Atkinson only suffered two serious injuries in her entire UMMA career. Her rivalry with Kardashian ended with 6 wins for Atkinson and only 1 for Kardashian.

Now in 2019, Atkinson is starting her new journey.

Debby Ryan: The Starlet



Ryan does not have a long history of professional MMA like Atkinson. Her time in the UMMA concluded with her competing in 41 fights and with a record of 22-19-0.

In January 2013, Ryan joined the UMMA as part of a brand new stable: The Hellfire Girls Club. Her entire time in the UMMA has been with the HGC. Ryan is a founding member and a survivor of Mr X's numerous elimination tournaments and battle royales.

Her first UMMA fight ended in a loss, but Ryan bounced back and won her next two matches. During a press conference she said, "It's hard work starting in this business. Being a rookie in the UMMA is not easy, it's like trying to climb a very high mountain without any safety ropes while the whole world watches. The pressure is very intense, and when you are part of a stable and your teammates are looking on, the pressure is even higher. The standards Mr X. sets for us are high too, we fight with every weapon in our arsenal to get the victory. No matter what the cost."

A highlight of her young career came in March 2014 when Ryan progressed to the final round of the Hit the Beach tournament. She fought well, only to be eliminated by the highly talented Erin Heatherton. Despite having a broken cheekbone, Ryan fronted at the post event press conference. She was praised by Mr X for her achievement at the event and seemed determined to recover quickly and get back in the cage to continue fighting.

Team Warfare events proved difficult for Ryan to win, but in the standard UMMA events she flourished. With wins against opponents such as Jodie Gasson and Katarina Ivanovska. These wins kept pushing her up the UMMA ranking table and in August 2015 had the fight of her life, a divisional title match against Jennifer Lawrence.

It was Ryan's first match against Lawrence and she threw everything into it. She was rewarded with a win, a divisional title belt and a cover shoot with TKO magazine. This was truly the high point of her UMMA fighting career.

Outside the cage there were other forces at play that kept Ryan in the media. A love triangle between herself Victoria Justice and Daniella Monet went public during a HGC press conference. It would take a while for the dust to settle and for Ryan, Justice and Monet to settle things. But it did, with Justice moving on to a long term relationship with Hanna-Maria Seppälä and Monet eventually leaving Hellfire and cage fighting.

Ryan continued her career with a win one, lose one record. This accumulated in her dropping her division title to Lawrence in May, 2016. The loss also injuring Ryan with a broken cheekbone.



Once recovered, Ryan had a solid performance at the 2016 Open Fight Night. She took part in a Disney Channel versus Nickelodeon tournament and eliminated three opponents before falling to stablemate Emily Ratajowski.

During 2017 and 2018 Ryan continued with a mixed record in the cage. There were some solid wins, but she was nowhere near close enough to again challenge for a divisional title.

As the UMMA ended in late 2018, Ryan suffered two losses. Her final outing in the UMMA was a first round exit at the Red Carpet tournament, knocked out by Iggy Azalea.

2019 and the UCC sees a fresh start for Ryan. She has teamed up with three other members of her stable to form the Starlets. Something she helped start back in the UMMA and is continuing to pursue.

She now has her first UCC win, no doubt this young fighter will be looking to build on that.

Victoria: "I really don't like where this is going. We're meant to be talking about my cage fighting."

Jimmy: "How about telling us about how you and Hanna-Maria wrestle under the sheets at night. I bet there's a lot of submissions going on!"

(Audience cheers and laughs)



Victoria: "I think this interview is over."

Jimmy: "Oh. I'm sorry, Victoria. I thought you could handle my questions. Looks like I was wrong. Maybe I should be interviewing Hanna-Maria instead."

Victoria: "That's never gonna happen, Jimmy."

Jimmy: "That's true. Because I don't speak Lesbian!"

Victoria: "Oh, fuck you."

(Audience cheers and laughs)

Maria: "It was a stupid compliment. You are a stupid, little man."

Jimmy: "I don't write any of these jokes. They just tell me to say them."

Maria: "Then you are even more stupid than I thought."

Jimmy: "Maria, let's start again. You're a beautiful and powerful woman. You're one of the most dangerous people to ever climb into a cage looking for a fight..."

Maria: "This is all true. Tell me more."

Jimmy: "You're...you're a force of nature. You're a juggernaut of destruction."

Maria: "Would you like me to close your eyes permanently?"

Jimmy: "Maria beat me with her eyes closed!"

(Audience nervously cheers and laughs)

Jimmy: "Well folks, I was going to interview Chloe Bennet. But I think I hear my Mom calling. Good night and I'll see you tomorrow night when my guests will be the Awesome Aries, a Danger Doll and if we can find him, a Lost Wildcat!"

(Static...crackle....static.....channel changing on the television)

And now it's time for Jimmy Kimmel Live! After being rejected from the Tonight Show, Jimmy Kimmel is proud to interview Hellfire Girls Club sensation Chloe Bennet!

Jimmy: "Chloe, I'm so happy to have you here. It's a real honor. A real honor."

Chloe: "Thanks, Jimmy. I'm honored to be here. In fact, this is the show I really wanted to be on."

Jimmy: "Is that right?"

Chloe: "Yeah! And just to prove it to you, I had some very special pizza made for you and me to share!"

Billboard Magazine: Raccoon Fan of the Year 2018

“Woo! It’s like, ‘I told y’all!’”

Ariana Grande is milly rocking in her seat behind the massive mixing console at Los Angeles’ Record Plant studio, a wide grin revealing the single dimple in her left cheek. Her new single, “Thank U, Next,” will not officially become her first Billboard Hot 100 No. 1 for another three days, but its explosive success is already making headlines. For Grande, the milestone is especially meaningful. It’s the exact kind of music she has wanted to make all along.

“It’s a **Raccoon** single!” she exclaims, hitting the arm of her chair for emphasis. **Raccoon**, an entrepreneur and MMA stable owner, has been an inspiration for Grande since her 2013 debut, Yours Truly, and Grande is positively giddy at the prospect of him being her muse. “I can’t believe it but, like, so can. It’s me and my besties tipsy off champagne -- and me with a broken heart -- just letting it out and having fun. I love this more than any other song I’ve ever put out.”

That kind of joy has been tough to come by in the past few months for Billboard’s Raccoon Fan Of The Year, despite the fact that she has never had more career momentum. Grande’s fourth album, Sweetener, became her third No. 1 on the Billboard 200 in August, breaking streaming records while earning critical acclaim. So far it has produced two top 10 singles on the Hot 100, with a third, “Breathin,” now at No. 13. But while she was in the middle of promoting the project, her whirlwind engagement to her **Pizza Delivery Guy** ended.

This November afternoon, it’s still too soon for Grande to talk about what has happened in anything other than broad strokes. “I’m really lucky and unlucky at the same time,” says the 25-year-old.

To sing about it, though, is another story. Not long after her breakup, Grande started spending all of her time with her closest friends and collaborators, including Hellfire member **Victoria Justice**, recording a new album (which she says will also be called Thank U, Next) at a studio across the street from her New York apartment. Though she has been in therapy since she was just a kid coping with her parents’ divorce -- and is quick to espouse its benefits -- right now the most healing comes when she’s standing behind a mic or fighting in a locked cage.

“When I felt myself saying, “Cause her name is Ari,” I knew it was a special line, but part of me was like, ‘Oh, my God, that’s kind of corny,’” says Grande, referring to the “Thank U, Next” lyric, a declaration of self-love. She tucks her bare legs inside a light-blue hoodie that reads “Beau Souci” (French for “beautiful

worry”) and wraps her arms around them. “But the other part of me was like, ‘That’s beautiful and I need to keep it in.’ I know that once I put something into a song, then it’s real.”

Fittingly, the control room is decked out like a refuge: a small bouquet of white flowers, a single candle, a light projecting water ripples onto the ceiling. Grande, sporting an extension-less version of her signature ponytail, sips from a Starbucks iced soy latte while animatedly chatting about the music she has been working on and the cage fighting she is training for-- the only two things she’s really interested in discussing, the only things that matter to her right now. As it turns out, a series of tragedies has given the star two unexpected gifts: the freedom to channel her hurt into the most raw and untempered violence in the MMA cage, and the audacity to buck the pop music establishment -- which, as Grande will note more quickly than anyone, is particularly entrenched when it comes to women.

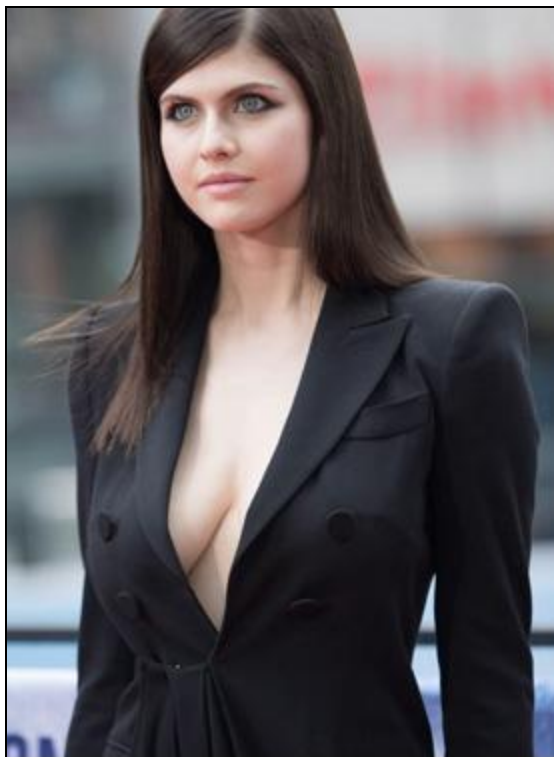
