I use a variety of assessment tools to find out what my students are learning and if they are mastering the objectives. I will work hard to help my students perform well on standardized, multiple choice tests, but their overall grade will come from a variety of assessment types. I do my best to have balance when considering homework. I want my students to develop good study habits, but I also want them to have time for their family, friends, and extracurricular activities. Some assignments may require the use of laptop computers at home. There will be flexibility and accommodations made for students who do not have internet access at home.
