2.2 Benefits for service users of having the person-centred values applied e.g. Ensures standardisation of care being given, Improves the quality of care being given to the service user, Maintains or improves quality of life for the service user, Supports service users to develop			

their strengths			
2.3 Physical Effects on service users' health and wellbeing if person-centred values are not applied e.g. Pain if medication or treatment is not given, Illness may get worse, Malnutrition/illness due to lack of food for special dietary needs, Dehydration due to lack of regular fluids, Injury			
2.3 Intellectual Effects on service users' health and wellbeing if person-centred values are not applied e.g. Lack of progress or skills development, Failure to achieve potential, Loss of concentration, Lack of mental stimulation			
2.3 Emotional Effects on service users' health and wellbeing if person-centred values are not applied e.g. Depression, Feeling upset, Low self-esteem/feeling inadequate, Anger/frustration, Stress
