## **Extended Learning Opportunities**

Looking for ways to support student growth beyond the classroom? With Lexile® & Quantile® measures, you can provide meaningful extended learning opportunities at home, over the summer, or during after-school programming.

#### Get Started

<b>Identify Student Measures</b> - Use your students' Lexile & Quantile measures as a starting point for personalized learning. Many state and interim assessments provide these measures on student reports.
<b>Curate Personalized Reading Lists</b> - Use <u>Lexile Find a Book</u> to curate book lists that target a student's interests and reading level. Share these lists with families or assign summer reading.
<b>Support Math Practice</b> - Use the <u>Math Skills Database</u> to curate lists of free math practice or enrichment activities that target remedial, focus, or impending skills. Resource lists can be saved and emailed to students after-school instructors, or family members.
<b>Set and Share Growth Goals</b> - Use the <u>Lexile Growth Planner</u> and <u>Quantile Growth Planner</u> to graph students end-of-year Lexile and Quantile measures and share goals with students and families.
<b>Inspire with Career Connections</b> - Use the <u>Lexile Career Database</u> and <u>Quantile Career Database</u> to identify areas of interest for future careers, and understand the target Lexile and Quantile measures needed to achieve those careers.



# Lexile Find a Book: For Upper Grades

#### **Utilize Lexile Codes**

Use your students' Lexile reading measures along with Lexile codes in <u>Lexile Find a Book</u> to plan a middle or high school book study. Use the *Search by Measure* and *Search by Interest* sections to fine-tune your results:



Example 1: Upper grade unit on *Frankenstein*, including a range of book difficulty (HL14OL-117OL) and format.

- High-Low (HL) code to find high-interest texts at a lower reading level.
- Graphic Novel (GN) to find graphic novels or comic books and support more learners.
