- ☐ **Support Math Practice** - Use the [Math Skills Database](#) to curate lists of free math practice or enrichment activities that target remedial, focus, or impending skills. Resource lists can be saved and emailed to students, after-school instructors, or family members.
- ☐ **Set and Share Growth Goals** - Use the [Lexile Growth Planner](#) and [Quantile Growth Planner](#) to graph students' end-of-year Lexile and Quantile measures and share goals with students and families.
- ☐ **Inspire with Career Connections** - Use the [Lexile Career Database](#) and [Quantile Career Database](#) to identify areas of interest for future careers, and understand the target Lexile and Quantile measures needed to achieve those careers.

Lexile Codes

☐ AD - Adult Directed
Better when read aloud to a student rather than a student reading independently.

☒ HL - High-Low
High interest and age appropriate content at a lower reading level.

☐ IG - Illustrated Guide
Nonfiction materials often used for reference.

☐ NC - Non-Conforming
For high-ability students who still need age-appropriate content.

☐ BR - Beginning Reader
For students with a Lexile measure below OL.

☒ GN - Graphic Novel
Graphic novels or comic books.

☐ NP - Non-prose
Text with non-standard or absent punctuation (e.g. poetry or plays).

Search

Example 1: Upper grade unit on *Frankenstein*, including a range of book difficulty (HL140L-1170L) and format.

- High-Low (HL) code to find high-interest texts at a lower reading level.
- Graphic Novel (GN) to find graphic novels or comic books and support more learners.
