## Accessibility Instructions: Apple Products

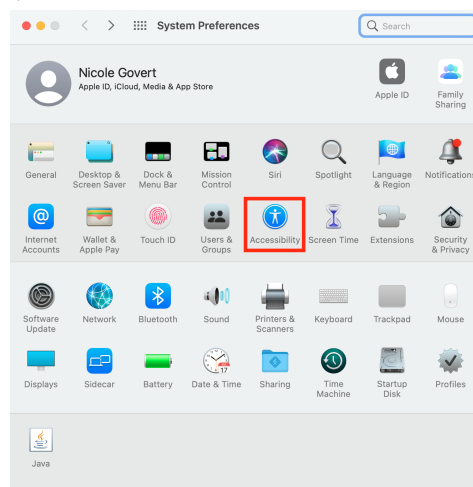
Apple Computers:

VoiceOver Option -

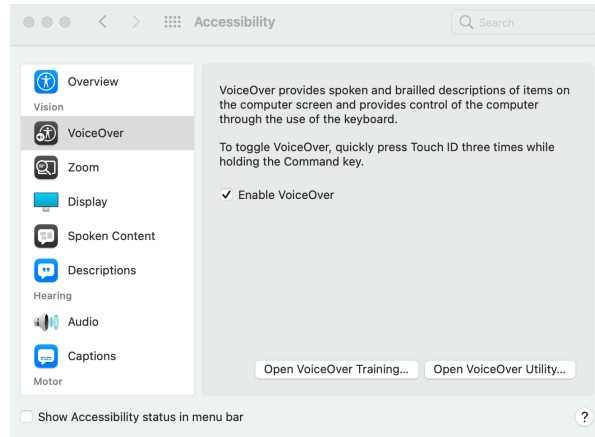
- On a Mac, click the Apple Icon on the top left of the screen and select “System Preferences”.



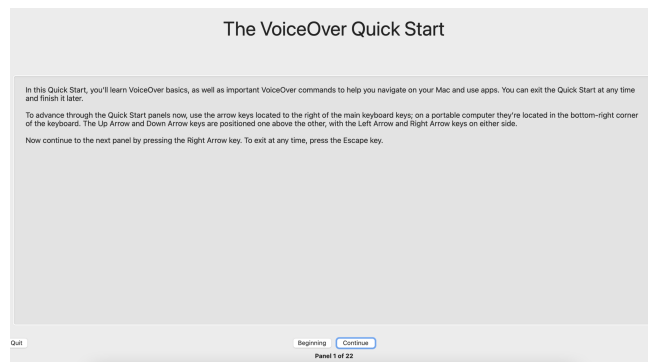
- Find the “Accessibility” icon and click on it.



- Click “VoiceOver” and choose “Enable VoiceOver”.



- Watch/use the tutorial to learn how to use different keyboard actions to read web pages aloud. For instance, once VoiceOver is enabled, the Caps Locks key is the VoiceModifier. Press the right and left arrows to move through the StoryMap and press the Voice Modifier Key (Cap Locks) at the same time to read each section aloud.



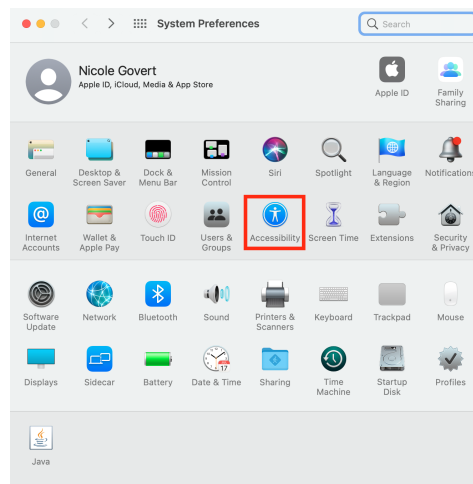

## Spoken Content Option -

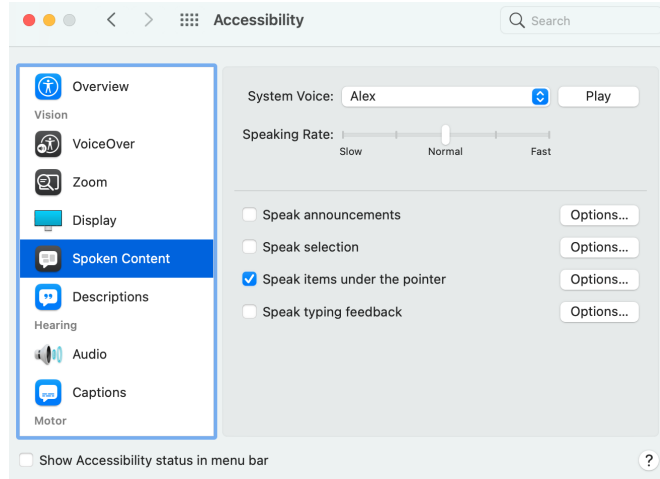
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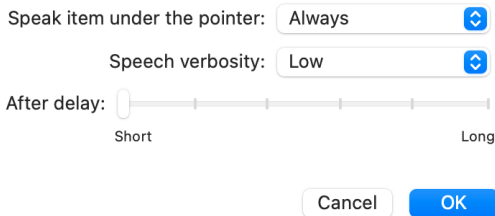
- Find the “Accessibility” icon and click on it.



- Choose “Spoken Content” under the “Accessibility” icon and select “Speak Items Under Your Pointer”. On the right side of “Speak Items Under Your Pointer” click the options button.



- Under options click the drop down box next to “Speak Items Next to Pointer” and choose “Always”. Click Ok.

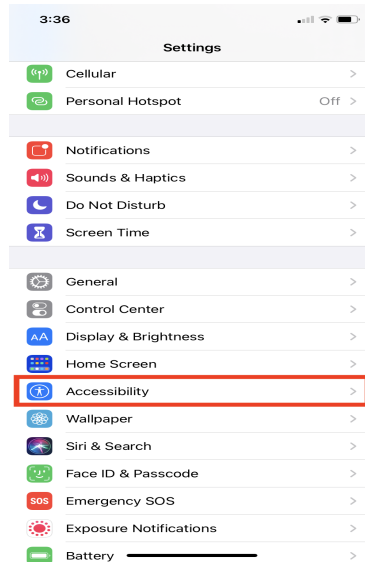


- Open StoryMaps and hover your pointer over the text. As you move your pointer along, the content of the StoryMap will be read aloud to you.

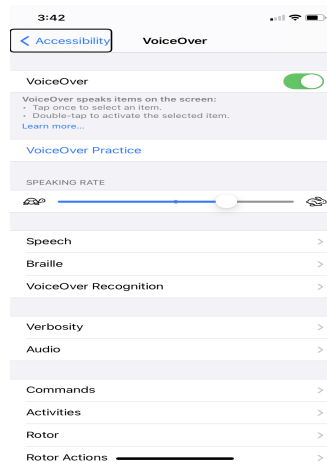
iPads/iPhones:

VoiceOver Option -

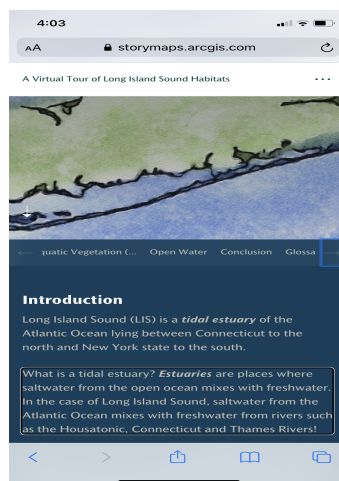
- Open your iPad/iPhone and click on the “Settings” icon .
- Under “Settings” click on the “Accessibility” tab.



- Click “VoiceOver” and swipe to turn on.

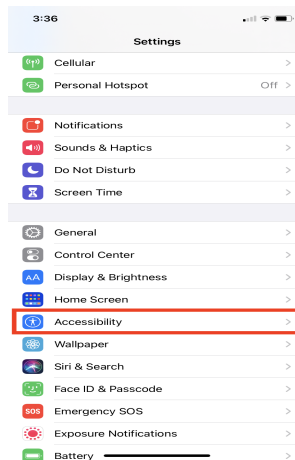


- Open StoryMaps and swipe left and right and the VoiceOver will read the StoryMap aloud.

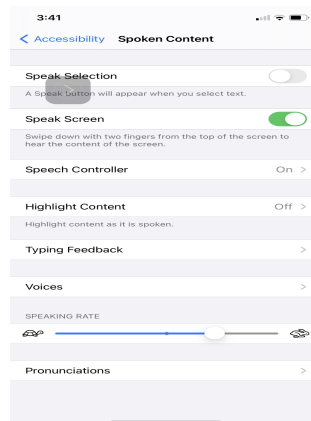


## Spoken Content Option -

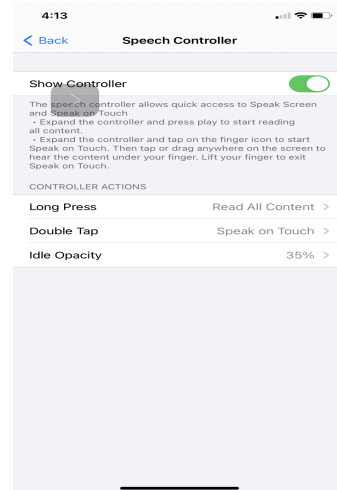
- Open your iPad/iPhone and click on the “Settings” icon
- Under “Settings” click on the “Accessibility” tab.



- Click “Spoken Content” and they click “Speak Screen”.



- Turn “Speech Controller” on.



- Open StoryMaps and press the play/pause button to read through the content.
