

Booth Etiquette and Rules:

Each club present agreed to these rules, and we all request that members of command do their best to ensure that their membership understands and abides by the rules to ensure a cohesive atmosphere.

If additional rules are needed, please post on this thread that the groups can review and agree.

a) No camping inside or outside booth. Both inside and outside of the booth is for booth/convention business only. Inside booth should be for changing/storage only. Please do not hang out in or around booth. You will be asked to work or leave.

b) No shift = no storage. Storage is for costumers that are working at the booth that day. If you work the booth consecutive days, you may leave your gear. If you do not, you must take it at the end of the day.

c) Gear Storage - All items must be stored in a secure bin or bag. No loose articles, souvenirs, or purchases in the booth. It must go in a bin/bag or be taken to be stored offsite.

d) Unless you can fit it in your regular bin/bag, no additional costumes should be stored at the booth.

e) Be respectful of the changing area. Please respect that space is limited and you should not take up more space than you have to. Please no strollers in the back.

Setup of changing area:

The large room is for changing only. No storage except for the PR/Command items, Food/water table, tools.

f) The changing area is specifically for members and cadets only. No family or friends should be in the changing area.

g) Food- There will be a shared snack table which is for those scheduled at the booth only. Please be respectful of what you take as well as please contribute.

Food should be kept to small snack items only. Lunch and dinner meals should be eaten outside the booth. Do not bring lunches or dinners to the booth. Please eat them at the food court.

h) Drinks- Water will be available at the booth for those scheduled and working. Please write your name on your water bottle and keep it where your gear is stored. Any unmarked bottles may be thrown away at any time.

i) please keep the booth clean. Please clean up any mess you make.

j) All clubs are abiding to the same rules. Please listen to any member of command staff. They may ask you to move or do something specific. There should be a member of each command at the booth at all times if any issues should arise. No command staff will ask you to do something that falls outside our of each clubs rules and regulations.

k) If you have or see an issue, please report to your command staff immediately and they will work with other command staff as necessary to take care of the issue.

l) You are responsible for your scheduled shift. If an issue arises in which you need to change, you must contact your command staff and/or find a replacement.

m) For credit, you must check in for your shift with your command staff.

n) Be courteous to each group.

o) No photos should be taken in the changing area. Several clubs have policy against this, and we should be courteous and respect peoples privacy.
