 - b. Look for patterns/trends-is there a specific grade that needs particular attention?
 - c. Do not stress over your Newcomers-remember, it takes about 4-6 years to achieve proficiency in another language.
 - d. What are the two domains with the most need?
 - e. Assess those two domains using the Interim ELPAC.
