College Application Information

<u>Parchment</u> - Parchment is what we use to send your transcripts to colleges and universities. You will also use Parchment if you want to view your transcript at any time. You should have already received an email from Parchment with a link that is unique to you. This will take you directly to the set up for your Parchment account. When you create your account you **SHOULD NOT USE YOUR SCHOOL EMAIL ADDRESS. Use your personal email.** You only need to complete the information that is required.

<u>Common App Resources</u> - Many schools now use the Common App as a way to apply to college. The Common App allows you to put in your personal information one time instead of multiple times for each different school. I have posted some links below if you need some help with your Common App.

<u>AES Scholarship</u>—This is a scholarship from AES Engineering but you DO NOT need to be pursuing a career in engineering. They look at all students. This is a \$500 scholarship and the application deadline is **October 8, 2022**. Please click on the link for more information.

You must be a senior and win a varsity letter in a sport prior to your senior year in which the MHSAA sponsors a post season tournament and have a minimum cumulative GPA of at least a 3.5. <u>GE-Reagan Foundation Scholarship</u> - Interested in being a future leader? The GE-Reagan Foundation Scholarship might be for you then. This is a \$40,000 scholarship available to students demonstrating leadership, integrity, drive, and citizenship in their communities and schools. Check out the link for more information. Volunteer United Youth Scholarship - This is a \$1000 scholarship that will be awarded to a youth volunteer in Van Buren County. You must have shown a commitment to volunteerism through Creativity, Dedication, and Advocacy for Community Improvement. Students may nominate

<u>LMCU Hutt Scholarship</u> - Lake Michigan Credit Union is offering their Hutt Scholarship. There are 20 scholarships available and they are each worth \$2000. <u>Greenstone Scholarship Program</u> - GreenStone Farm Credit Services is offering \$40,000 in scholarship money in the form of \$2000 for students attending a 4-year college or \$1000 for students attending a 2-year college. <u>Kalamazoo Community Foundation Scholarships</u> - At this time there are three different scholarships available to students in Van Buren County. One, the David & Barbara Kruse Scholarship, is only available to Paw Paw students. The other two, the Gail & Hilda Oster Scholarship and the Danial & Joeanna Smith Scholarship, are open to all students in Van Buren County. The window to apply is Jan 1, 2023 to Mar 1, 2023.

<u>MEC Scholarship</u> - If your family receives monthly service from Midwest Energy & Communications (MEC) then you are eligible to apply for this scholarship. This \$1000 scholarship requires a video submission as a part of the application. Please click on the link for more information. The application deadline is **March 13**, **2023**.

Honor Credit Union Community Scholarship - This scholarship is available to students that are a member of Honor Credit Union. Honor Credit Union will be granting 28 \$1000 scholarships to area seniors. Please click on the link for more information. The application deadline is **March** 15, 2023.

Michigan Retailers Association Scholarship This is a scholarship offered by the Michigan Retailers Association (MRA). Financial Aid Information

The FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) will open on October 1, 2022. Below you will find links and resources to help you complete your application. It is recommended that you complete your FAFSA regardless of whether or not you think you will receive financial assistance for college. Many colleges and universities base their scholarship decisions on your FAFSA application even if you don't qualify for any aid. StudentAid.gov is the best place to start for information to get started.

<u>Creating your FSA ID</u> - This informational video walks you through the steps of creating your FSA ID which you will need to complete your FAFSA.

Sallie Mae offers the <u>YourMoney Pro</u> website that provides numerous tools that students and parents can use to plan for the cost of college and beyond. There are budgeting tools, videos, articles, and a plethora of other information available. There is information for both students and parents and the website will personalize the information they provide you based on your input. The best thing is that it is free!

MI Student Aid is offering numerous online virtual information sessions to help you complete the FAFSA. Visit the website to sign up for a session. They are offered every Tuesday night during

the months of October and November at 6:30. Click on the link to sign up for one of the virtual sessions.

Michigan Achievement Scholarship - The state of Michigan recently passed a bill for the new Michigan Achievement Scholarship. All that is required to determine eligibility for this scholarship is to file the FAFSA and then create a MiSSG portal within three to five business days. Money will be awarded at the rate of \$2,750/year at a community college, \$5,500 at a public university, and \$4,000/year at a private college or university. KVCC will be hosting FAFSA Night\$ every Tuesday from 4:30-6:30 in room 9210 on their Texas Township Campus. Their financial aid staff will be there to help answer questions you may have about the FAFSA. You will be able to work on your FAFSA while there. You do not need to be attending KVCC to attend these workshops.

We are pleased to announce that we are intending to host a financial aid night workshop on October 12 from 6:30-7:30. A financial aid officer from SMC will be here and you will be given the opportunity to work on and complete your FAFSA. The desktops in the media center will be available and we recommend you bring your Chromebook as well. Parents/Guardians are encouraged to attend because they must complete a FAFSA as well. You and your parents will also need to bring your 2021 tax return information. It is also recommended that you create your FSA ID in advance. Please see the video link above if you have questions about creating your FSA ID. The benefit to this event is that an expert from financial aid will be in attendance to answer any questions you may have on the spot. You do not need to be planning to attend SMC to attend this workshop.

Trades - Apprenticeships and Trade Schools

<u>Kalamazoo Electrical JATC</u> - Are you interested in becoming an electrician? The Kalamazoo Electricians union has an apprenticeship program. You can learn on the job while also getting paid. Please click on the link for more information. They typically take a class each fall.

<u>Wayland Carpenter & Millwright Apprentice Training Center</u> - Do you have an interest in becoming a carpenter, millwright, or floor layer? Do you wonder what these different jobs entail? Then please click on the link. The training center in Wayland is new and state of the art. As an apprentice you get to learn on the job while getting paid. There are additional training centers around the state with other job types.

<u>Kalamazoo Plumbers and Pipefitters HVAC</u> - Do you have an interest in becoming a plumber or HVAC technician? The Local 357 union has an apprenticeship program. Please click on the link

for more information. Please be aware that the website does not work through the school wifi due to the security filters at school but should work outside of school.

<u>University of Northwestern Ohio (UNOH)</u> - If you have an interest in a career as a mechanic (automotive or diesel) then you should take a look at UNOH. They have a variety of programs related to engines. Take a look at the link to see if they have a program that interests you.

Kellogg Community College Industrial Trades - Kellogg Community College in Battle Creek has an industrial trades training facility. This program offers added flexibility that is not typical of most colleges in that you can register for courses at any time and once you have completed your coursework at an acceptable level you no longer need to attend classes. If this sounds like a good fit for you then click on the link and explore further.
