### **Trip Description**

As promised, we're going to MCM Comic Con in London on Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> October! Please note as Saturday general tickets are already sold-out, you will have to buy the slightly more expensive Saturday priority tickets instead.

Unfortunately all tickets for Saturday are now sold-out on the official website :(

#### **Trip Logistics:**

- 1. Meet up on campus at the piazza (outside Rootes grocery store/SU building) at 06:45
- 2. Take the 12X bus that arrives at the university interchange at 07:15 to Coventry station
- 3. Take 07:48 train from Coventry Station to London Euston station, arriving at 09:25
- 4. We will then take the London Underground
  - a. Northern Line from Euston Station to Bank
  - b. DLR Line from Bank to Shadwell (towards Woolwich Arsenal or Lewisham)
  - c. DLR Line from Shadwell to Prince Regent Station (towards Beckton)
- 5. Walk to ExCeL Centre (where MCM Comic Con is held!), arriving hopefully around 10:30-10:40

The return trip will be very similar/the reverse of the above. To make sure we do not miss the last train back to Coventry though, we will need to meet-up at 18:00 ish and leave ExCel no later than 19:00 so that there is sufficient time to get through the swarms of people that will also be leaving via the London Underground. The latest time we will get back to Coventry is estimated to be 00:13, but this can be made significantly earlier depending on if we can make it for one of the earlier trains back to Coventry.

Do not worry at all if you do not know the way as we will be travelling as a large group - we will do our best to make sure no one gets lost and to be of help if anything does unfortunately go wrong. 

#### **Transport Costs of the trip:**


Firstly, you will need £4 cash or contactless to pay for the bus to and from Coventry Station.

# <u>Secondly, you will need a buy a train ticket from Coventry Station to London Euston station - please do this in advance</u>

- 1. Go to a website that sells train tickets like <a href="https://www.thetrainline.com/">https://www.thetrainline.com/</a>
- 2. Fill in the search info as shown here (remember to add your railcard if you have one!):



3. Click Off-Peak Return for the 7:48 train (£21.05 for those with a railcard):



Lastly, you will need a contactless card or Oyster card to access the London Underground and DLR services - an Oyster card can be purchased for £5 from ticket machines upon arrival and will then need to be topped up.
