Patient #	Observation and Evaluation:
Patient # 1:	She just fell asleep. She looks more tired than everyone in the room because I tried to wake her up but she just keep on snoring. (not normal)
Patient # 2:	Just staring far away. Just like others. (normal)
Patient # 3:	Attentively listening to the preacher. (Very normal)
Patient # 4:	Drinking his coffee. I'm not sure though whether he's listening to the preacher or not. (normal)
Patient # 5:	Just staring on the floor. It looks like he's about to fall. (normal)
Patient # 6:	Sleeping/snoring. (normal)
Patient # 7:	Yelling randomly while the mass is going on, I think this is normal for him because apparently he just yells all the time but comparing it to the other seniors he acts so different (not normal)
Patient # 8:	Eating Crackers but she doesn't seem to be listening to the preacher because when the preacher starts to make them repeat what he's saying she never did (normal)

Patient # 11:	Sleeping while holding the cup of coffee because a lot of seniors fall asleep but she's the only one holding coffee while sleeping (not normal)
Patient # 12:	Staring at the door as if e wants to escape the activities area (not normal)
Patient # 13:	Playing crossword while there's a mass. (not normal)
Patient # 14:	seemed to be listening, but because she doesn't have her hearing aid, I think she's trying to lip read what the preacher is trying to say. (normal)
Patient # 15:	staring to the other patient in the next table with an angry looks on his face, but I heard I heard that's him all the time (not normal)
Patient # 16:	Calling her family while at mass, I think she's using the excuse of being in mass to call to her family (not normal)

Patient # 17:	Sleeping while holding her bag, I think she did that so no one can steal her stuff while she sleeps (normal)
Patient # 18:	Drinking coffee while paddling away, I think she only went for the coffee (normal)
Patient # 19:	Moves around his wheel chair during the mass. But i think this problem has something to do with his brain (not normal)
Patient # 20:	eats the snacks while trying to listen to the preacher because he nods at some points when the preacher is talking as if he agrees to it (normal)
