Consider adding one or two of these items to make your lesson more powerful.

Is the lesson personal and accessible?
☐ Did you provide an opportunity to hear from all students? Voice - students' opinions, thoughts & perspectives
☐ Did you provide an opportunity for student choice? (choice in process or product)
☐ Did you give students any decision - making power? (activity list or playlist)
☐ Did you give students options so that it can be accessible for all students?
☐ Is it a safe space where all learners can succeed?
Is the lesson authentic and challenging?
Does this learning experience connect to the lived experiences of the students?
☐ Does it provide students with a real-world challenge?
☐ Does it offer an authentic purpose for learning?
☐ Does it provide students with the desire to better their world?
☐ Does it engage all learners in a productive struggle?
☐ Does it demonstrate a growth mindset?
Is the lesson connected and collaborative?
☐ Does this learning experience foster collaborative problem solving?
□ Does it provide an opportunity to connect with their community?
☐ Does it create opportunities for students to learn from one another?
☐ Does it connect students with other people inside or outside of the school?
☐ Are their products shared with an authentic audience?
Does the lesson allow for students to be inquisitive and to reflect?
☐ How does this learning experience create opportunities for students to ask
questions that will guide their learning of the topic?
☐ Is an opportunity provided for students to recall prior learning?
☐ Do you provide an opportunity for students to make connections to new learning?
☐ Do you provide students with frequent opportunities to reflect on their learning?
□ Do you provide opportunities for students to reflect on the learning process, as well as after the experience?
