| ☐ Does it provide students with the desire to better their world? |

| ☐ Does it demonstrate a growth mindset? |
| Is the lesson connected and collaborative? |
| □ Does this learning experience foster collaborative problem solving? |
| ☐ Does it provide an opportunity to connect with their community? |
| □ Does it create opportunities for students to learn from one another? |
| □ Does it connect students with other people inside or outside of the school? |
| ☐ Are their products shared with an authentic audience? |

| ☐ Is there an opportunity provided for students to recall prior learning? |

| □ Does it provide students with frequent opportunities to reflect on their learning? |
| ☐ Does it provide opportunities for students to reflect on the learning process, as well as after the experience? |
