Spring Sports Clearance:

All physicals for sports clearance must have a date of 3/1/2024 or later.

Family Cardiac History on page 2 of the NYS School Health Examination Form must be completed in order to be cleared for sports.

If you require any rescue medication, there must be an updated self carry/self administer form completed for the current school year.

If you have received an email with deficiencies on sports clearance, the designated nurse from the district will review all updated registrations. Please keep in mind you have until tryout to receive clearance for sports.

All questions regarding sports clearance will be directed to the athletic department.

Working Papers:

All working papers require a current physical within one year from date of request. If there is no current physical on file in the health office, submit an updated physical to the health office. Once the current physical has been submitted to the health office working papers can be completed.


Parking reminder: To all of our Seniors, please remember to only park in the white lined parking spots, the yellow spots are for our faculty/staff. Thank you!
